AMERICAN LEGION BASEBALL COACH

Part-time (June – July estimated timeframe, primarily weekdays, some weekends, approximately 8 weeks)

Contracted employment annually, salary, paid monthly

Coaches average 4-5 contact days with the team per week; practices 1-2 hours in length; games dates average 4-6 hours of work and longer with travel. Coaches can generally set the team's practice times.

Minimum Requirements

18 years of age, high school diploma, pass a background check, complete concussion training, played baseball

Preferred Qualifications

Education degree or equivalent, coaching certification, previous baseball coaching experience

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Teaches and models the “core values” of the DGF Baseball Club and its mission statement.
- Instructs and demonstrates skill sets and techniques necessary for individual and team achievement in baseball.
- Plans and sets-up activities, effective practices/schedules and games.
- Maintains baseball field(s) before and after practices and games.
- Ensures that proper cleaning, storage, and maintenance of all athletic equipment and uniforms and updated inventories are adhered to.
- Arranges and communicates transportation for team members.
- Travels with athletes on the team bus (if used) both to and from games.
- Works with Club officers in communicating baseball practice and game schedules.

- Supervises students to ensure appropriate behavior at practices and games.
