Description

Nicholas Penza (BHS '15) participated in the Bellingham Youth Baseball Inc. program until his untimely death in February 2016. Nick was not only passionate about baseball, he was also passionate about being a supportive teammate. Fans could hear his loud encouragement for his teammates as they went up to bat or on the field. No matter which way the game went, he was a bright light and made the game fun.

Nick was also a member of the Bellingham High School baseball team, notably the 2014 State Championship team. He is remembered for being a good baseball player; but, even more so, being a good teammate.

From Danielle Penza, Nick's mom: "Nick started with the BYBI at the young age of 5 and by 9 years old he knew baseball was his soul. For Nick, it wasn't all about playing the game, but about the camaraderie and his love for team spirit. He gave his heart and soul into everything he did. Being in the BYBI wasn't just about baseball, it was his home away from home. It was about being at the baseball fields, feeling the love and support from his coaches, teammates and everyone on the board at BYBI who helped shape Nick in to the outstanding player, loyal and devoted teammate and friend everyone knew, loved and respected."

- a minimum of **two recommendations:** both from a non-relative community member (one can be a teacher);
- **essay.**
