**Jennifer Ryan Motioned that Legacy Gymnastics can host Level 2, 3 Bronze, Silver and Gold State Meet, Debbie Klotz 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and all approved.**

**\*State Meet Concerns and Refund Policy**

Another cancelation, Covid19 concerns, 3 day meet, masks, temp checks, 50 kids on the floor, what can the committee do to help, and we do help with an extra equipment cost if a second set of equipment is needed.

Send to committee chair to be posted on our website your Profit and Loss statement of your state meet cost, in order to help with a refund and to show what cost go into hosting a state meet so that other gyms may show an interest in hosting and to help give the refunds if necessary.

**Jennifer Ryan Motioned that the P and L statement be handed in every 15 days, first on February 15, 2021 then March 1, 2021 and then March 15, 2021, the final P and L will be handed in on April 30, 2021.**

### **\*New Routine Compulsory Workshop/Kentucky Clinic**

**Date=June 19-20, 2021**

### **\*Judges for Championships**

All non judges on our committee, the subcommittee-Amanda, Shannon, Jennifer L. and Jennifer R. will work with Candace to find out all information needed to compile a list.

Judy Grant for sure will not be judging this meet season and possibly Terry Cooper.

We will use the list from last year due to the Covid19 cancelations of our state meet. Need to get back to the committee at least by January 2021 or beginning of February 2021.

### **\*Virtual Competitions**

We discussed what this would look like and if we have had any interest from other gyms to do this. USAG will be coming out with guidelines on how to run and use virtual competitions.
