# Locker Room Availability: NO

- ➤ Visiting School should enter the field by the Visitor Entrance. There will be Port-a-Johns available by the entrance.
- ➤ Buses should park on the street by the Visiting Team Entrance. (See attached map)

### **Game Logistics**

- LCL will be wearing dark uniforms and will have the west bench as the host school. Your team will have the <u>east</u> side of field. Looking at the press box from the field, your coaching staff will have the right side of the press box.
- ➤ Halftime will be 15 minutes plus a 3-minute warm-up.
- ➤ There will be a general pre-game introduction done over a PA system followed by the National Anthem. There will not be no individual player introductions.
- LCL will provide an athletic trainer and Hartland FD/EMS will be in attendance.
- Essential Sideline Staff: Officials, Chain Gang, ADs, Security/Game Management, Photographer, Press (based upon space & Availability), Conference Commissioner Please limit the number of coaches in the Press Box to 2 people

#### COVID-19 Guidelines

We are trusting that each team has their own procedures for screening athletes before they participate. LCL will pre-screens LCL athletes, but is NOT requiring this on-site for the opponent.

> Per WIAA guidelines and the governor's mandate, masks must be worn upon arrival to the meet venue and until the warm-ups have started. Face coverings are strong recommended in all settings where people may come in contact with others, including outdoors when maintain physical distance is not possible.

- Any participant who prefers to wear a cloth face covering during gameplay should be allowed to do so. Gaiter style masks are not permitted for football.
- Coaches and sideline personnel should wear masks when they are in the bench area when social distancing is not possible.
- Each participant and coach should bring a hand sanitizer (with at least 60% alcohol) and utilize regularly), towel, and water bottle.
- Maintain social distancing from all individuals whenever possible and eliminate unnecessary physical
- There will be no pre-game or postgame handshakes.
- Each team is responsible for supplying their own water.

# Spectator Guidelines & Parking

- We are allotting 2 spectators per Varsity rostered athlete and coach. All tickets are \$5.
- **Ticket pick-up** will take place at the Visitor Entrance starting at 6:00 pm on Friday. Please bring exact change as we are not taking electronic payment. All spectators must be on a pass list. NO walk ups will be accepted.
- A ticket will get you into the stadium where you can sit in the east visiting bleachers. The bleachers are marked with spots that space out the seating. Please sit at those spots unless you are in a family unit. There are standing room areas outside the bleachers if you elect to watch the game from that area.
- MASKS ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN WHILE SITTING IN THE BLEACHERS. While we are outside, the current Governor's mandate states that masks needs to be worn in that enclosed space: https://evers.wi.gov/Documents/COVID19/FaceCoveringFAO.pdf
- Masks are not required outside the bleachers if you can maintain social distance. Please be respectful and following standard social distancing guidelines.
- **Parking** Please park in the North LCL parking lot OR the street. The north lot by the football field is reserved for the Visiting Team & Spectators. See attached map.
