- Be prepared and help my child be prepared
- Support the coach's and umpire's decisions
- Attend practices and games whenever possible
- Don't coach from the sidelines
- Have fun and encourage my child to have fun and be safe
- Consequences: The HGSA rules and various codes of conduct apply to players, coaches, parents, and spectators as specified by each document. All will be strictly enforced and violations will be dealt with in the following manner:

Strike One: First violation. Player/Coach/Parent/Spectator will be asked to stop harassing comments or disruptive behavior.

Strike Two: Second violation. Player/Coach/Parent/Spectator will be asked to leave the field.

Strike Three: Third violation. Player/Coach/Parent/Spectator will be restricted from attending any other HGSA games or events for the remainder of the season. If the offending party does not comply to the restriction, the player associated with the offender will be ejected from the current game they are attending.

Any "Strikes" shall be immediately reported to the division coordinator by the coach of each team so that the division coordinator has a full understanding of the situation that occurred. "Strikes" are cumulative for each season.
