HOUSE RULES OF CONDUCT

Members of the Club will observe and uphold standards of conduct generally accepted by society. All members and guests are expected to assist with maintaining a safe, clean and orderly Club. Complaints will be brought to the attention of the Club Manager or Bartender On Duty.

AUTHORITY Members will respect and honor the requests of GFAC Board Members, Club Manager and employees, whom are always the final authority.

ACCESS Access to the GFAC by members and their guests is conditional and may be revoked at any time. Member's are required by state law to carry their legal ID while in the GFAC bar areas and may also be required to produce their membership card at any time while on the premises.

GUESTS Guests must be accompanied by a GFAC member at all times who is responsible for their guest's welfare, attire, behavior and any damages. The number of guests authorized to accompany each GFAC member is at the discretion of the bartender on duty.

PHYSICAL VIOLENCE Physical violence by anyone will not be tolerated and will result in notification of the security police. All incidents of a physical attack on property or another person on the GFAC premises (inside or outside) must be reported to the Board of Governors to determine suitable disciplinary action.

OBSCENE OR PROFANE LANGUAGE Complaints about a member's language should be reported to the Board of Governors for appropriate action.

ATTIRE Shirt and shoes are required. Any properly worn military uniform and clean, serviceable civilian attire is appropriate. Hats are not worn inside the bar areas nor placed upon the bar. Additional guidance or temporary amendments may be provided for specific club events.

CHILDREN / PETS Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children and animals are not allowed. Anyone under the age of 18 is not permitted unless accompanied by an adult. Anyone under the age of 21 may not sit at the bar and will not be served alcohol beverages of any kind in anywhere on the premises.

ALCOHOL Alcohol use must be in compliance with all Idaho State laws. Only alcohol purchased from GFAC may be consumed on the premises.
