Expectations for Spring Ball

- Communicate with coaches if you will not be at practices due to illness/ tests/work/competing sport

Multi-Sport Participation:

- Keep up their academics

Team placements

- For June Ball, LWHS coaches will make determinations on team assignments and may move players around during June Ball
- For Fall Ball, LWBBA coaches will make determinations on team assignments and may move players around
- For official winter season, LWHS coaching staff make team decisions after tryouts in late November
