## SECTION 4AA GIRLS' 2024 HOCKEY TOURNAMENT

**DATES:** February 10, 13, 15, 2024

<u>COMPETING SCHOOLS</u> – East Ridge, Gentry Stars, Hill-Murray, Highland Park, Stillwater, Tartan/North, White Bear Lake, Woodbury Area

**SITE:** High Seeds & Aldrich Arena

**GAME TIMES:** Game times for quarter finals games will be determined by the host school. Please refer to the bracket on the MSHSL website for the other game times.

**ADMISSION:** Adults \$10.00 - Students/Seniors \$5.00

Method of tickets sales for ¼ final games will be determined by the high seed schools. Tickets for semi finals and finals must be purchased through Hometown Ticketing. <a href="https://mshsl4aa.hometownticketing.com/embed/all">https://mshsl4aa.hometownticketing.com/embed/all</a>

<u>PASSES:</u> Region 4AA will issue 12 administrative passes per member schools per season. Schools that compete in Region 4AA administered tournaments and are NOT in Region 4AA will receive 2 administrative passes for the AD and another administrator to use at the school's discretion. In addition to those two passes, each school will be allowed to send a list of up to 5 names to their opponent prior to the competition.

**BANNERS/SIGNS:** Section 4AA will permit banners/signs which are done in good taste. Athletic Directors/Administration of the participating schools are responsible for the nature of the banners. Arena management will determine where the banners may be hung. NO BANNERS/SIGNS CAN BE HUNG ON THE GLASS at Aldrich Arena.

**STREAMING:** Semifinals and finals will be streamed *exclusively* by Neighborhood Sports Network.

**LOCKER ROOMS:** It is recommended that no valuables be left in the locker room. NO CELL PHONES ARE ALLOWED IN THE LOCKER ROOMS.

**AWARDS:** There will be an awards ceremony following the conclusion of the championship game. The head coaches will distribute the medals to their respective players.

**RESCHEDULING OR CANCELATION OF A SECTION GAME:** If for some unforeseen reason, a section games needs to be postponed and re-scheduled, the tournament manager will coordinate a make-up date and location with the athletic administrators of the participating schools.

<u>VIDEO TAPING:</u> M.S.H.H.L. policy applies. Video taping is prohibited by anyone other than official school personnel.

## THE CONTEST

OFFICIAL SQUAD: 20 players are the maximum dressed to include a spare goalie, 2 student managers, 3 coaches; for a total of 25. The official squad is the roster submitted to the scorer when the first game is played.

**OFFICIALS:** All officials will be assigned by the assigner for the St. Paul Officials Association.

**TEAM BENCH:** The high seed team has choice.

## **GAME RULES:**

- Three (3) periods of seventeen (17) minutes.
- Eight (8) minute overtime periods.
- Six (6) goal rule applies.
- All MSHSL rules apply.
  - o In the event of a tie, the following rules/procedures apply.
  - o Teams remain at the bench area. Same ends/goals apply.
  - o Three (3) minute rest period, eight (8) minute sudden death overtime period.
  - o Make new ice, ten (10) minute intermission: play seventeen (17) minute sudden death overtime period.
  - Three (3) minute rest period at bench area; eight (8) minute sudden death overtime period.
  - o If tie remains, repeat C and D above. Change ends/goals.

**EQUIPMENT:** National Federation and MSHSL rules apply.

<u>UNIFORMS:</u> Higher seeded teams are the **home** and will wear **white.** Lower seeded teams are **visitors** and will wear **dark**.

**INTERMISSIONS:** No performances will be allowed on the ice.
