Season ahead

Mount Si Baseball is led by second-year Head Coach Karl Myers, a Mount Si PE teacher and five-year program veteran. Living locally alongside his wife and young daughter, Coach Myers is building a program that instills discipline, drives academic excellence, and unites the MSHS baseball community.

With Varsity, JV, and C-teams, we develop over 50 student-athletes and engage hundreds of local families.

Our program is a proven pathway to success. This year's seniors include four committed collegiate athletes headed to programs like University of Nevada (NV), Bellevue University (NE), and Shoreline College (WA).

In 2026, the Wildcats will take on KingCo rivals (Issaquah, Eastlake, Skyline), compete in the T-Mobile Park High School Classic, and travel to Spokane for early-season experience.

- **Coaching support:** MSHS funds one head coach at each of the three team levels. The Booster Club proudly supplements this with five additional coaching stipends, ensuring Varsity, JV, and C-team athletes receive the instruction and support they deserve.
- **Elite training equipment:** Before the 2026 season, the Booster Club purchased a new pitching machine to help sharpen player performance. For 2027, we'll partner with the coaching staff to identify and fund the next critical equipment need.
- **Collegiate-level travel experiences:** In 2026, the Varsity team will make its second trip to Gonzaga Prep, hosted at Gonzaga University. The program's goal is to establish this as an annual experience, building team chemistry, discipline, and readiness to compete after a long road trip.
- **Team apparel:** From uniforms and hats to practice gear, our players take pride in representing Mount Si. For 2027, the Booster Club aims to outfit the entire program with cold-weather jackets that can be used season after season.

With more than 1,000 Instagram followers and 550 Facebook followers, auction donors will be featured in targeted social posts promoting the event, reaching local families and community members in the weeks leading up to the auction.
