o <u>Jr. Mites/Mites</u>:

- o MAC Skate Rental Try Hockey for Free
 - Parents didn't know that skate rentals were not included, some didn't bring payment.
 Would the association cover the cost of the skate rental? Yes we want to cover this.
 Isaac will work with Todd on the details.
 - We'd like to be at the MAC for ease of everything. Seemed to run much smoother there, rather than the NHC.

o **Squirts:**

- Sitting pretty even for next year as far as numbers
- o Losing goalies, we may only have one per team next year, depending on teams
- o Tournaments are being processed
