LCACC meeting last night. A vote was passed to lower the number of athletes allowed on the mat from 40 to 30. BBFC JV and Varsity teams will expand into two separate competition teams. Freshman and Instructional previously expanded in 2023 & 2024. The JV and Varsity split will allow BBFC to take the older waitlisted athletes who have never been able to get into our program in previous years. With recent recruiting efforts, enrollment is up from previous years as well. As for game days, this will allow BBFC more flexibility in where they cheer on game days. LCACC will now allow Sideline-only teams. Brighton will look into adding this option in 2027.
