

USA Hockey Award Patch Request Form MN District 3

There are three award patches youth players may earn from USA Hockey:

- 1. Hat Trick Award For a player scoring 3 goals in one game.
- 2. Playmaker Award For a player registering 3 assists in one game.
- 3. Zero Club Award For a goalkeeper playing a complete game without allowing any goals. GOALKEEPER MUST PLAY ENTIRE GAME TO RECEIVE AWARD.

Player awards are distributed under the following conditions:

- 1. The recipient is a registered player.
- 2. The game was in league competition (not scrimmage or exhibition), a sanctioned tournament or a MN Hockey playoff involving only USA Hockey registered teams.
- 3. The game was officiated by registered USA Hockey referees.
- 4. A readable, unaltered copy of the score sheet with the players listed is required with the request form.
- 5. A copy of the official roster must be included with each request.
- 6. Limit of ONE of each award per player per season i.e., one Hat Trick, one Playmaker and one Zero
