

PAYSA Tee Ball Rules

1. Games will be three (3) innings or less than one (1) hour in length, whichever comes first.
2. Score is not kept.
3. Each team will bat their entire lineup every inning, meaning all players hit every inning. The hitting order for each team can be changed each inning.
4. Outs will not be officially recorded even if they are made. Each player will advance one base on every hit, with the exception of when the last batter is up. All runners on base when the last batter is up will round the bases and touch home plate; this includes the batter as well.
5. Each batter will be given an opportunity to hit off the tee and reach first base. Balls that do not travel far from the tee may be immediately deemed foul balls and another opportunity to hit provided to the batter.
6. Some or all players may be provided the opportunity to hit from a soft underhand toss from his/her coach instead of using the tee. Each player may get three coach 'pitches' to put the ball in play. If after three coach 'pitches' the player has not put the ball into the field of play, he/she will then be required to hit off the tee.
7. Both teams are responsible for setting up the field before the first game and/or putting away all equipment after the last game.
