



COVID GUIDELINES 2021-22 SEASON (Updated 1/4/22)

POSITIVE COVID TEST

Any fully vaccinated player, coach or SPVC personnel who receives a positive COVID test will not be allowed to return to participation until they have passed the following guidelines:

- Has been asymptomatic for at least 24 hours **AND**
- Five (5) days have passed since positive test (or initial symptoms occurred) **OR** has received two (2) negative test* results, at least 24 hours apart (OTC test results acceptable)

First negative test cannot be taken until at least 24 hours AFTER initial positive test was received

Any unvaccinated player, coach or SPVC personnel who receives a positive COVID test will not be allowed to return to participation until they have passed **EACH** of the following guidelines:

- Has been asymptomatic for at least 24 hours **AND**
- Ten (10) days have passed since positive test (or initial symptoms occurred)

CLOSE CONTACT W/ COVID POSITIVE PERSON

Any fully vaccinated player, coach or SPVC personnel who has a confirmed 'Close Contact' with a known infected person will NOT BE SUBJECT to a quarantine period subject to confirming **EACH** of the following:

- Has remained asymptomatic
- Received a negative test result upon being notified of 'Close Contact' (OTC test result acceptable) **OR** at least Five (5) days have passed since Close Contact occurred

Any unvaccinated player, coach or SPVC personnel who has a confirmed 'Close Contact' with a known infected person will not be allowed back to participation until:

- Five (5) days have passed since "close contact" occurred **AND**
- Has remained asymptomatic the entire time

Each family acknowledges their reporting responsibilities. All families must immediately report a positive COVID results to SPVC (notifying player's coach is acceptable).

Any player/family who does not report such results within an acceptable time frame is subject to discipline within the club.

No partial refunds will be provided for missed practice time due to positive test/close contact UNLESS practice is cancelled by SPVC.
