

Fraser Delta Interlock Guidelines

Overview

The Fraser Delta interlock will schedule and administer regular season and playoff games/standings for 13U A and AA, 15U A, 18U AA divisions.

Team construction

- 13U A and 15U A teams must be formed through a common drafted and created evenly as possible, see BC Minor rulebook.

Game days

- 13U A: Wednesday, Friday, Sunday
- 13U AA: Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday
Getting to “remote” parks (ex. North Shore) for mid-week games is a challenge. “Remote” teams will be scheduled with a lot of Saturday double headers. Won’t be able to avoid mid-week games for the playoffs.
Will do our best to work around the 13U AAA schedule for those parks that share 13U A/AA/AAA teams.
- 15U A: will work around Bantam AA and AAA schedules. AA typically Tues/Thurs/weekends. AAA typically weekends and Wed.
- 18U AA: based on field availability and requests

Start times

- Weekdays 5:30 PM in the month of April. 6:00pm starting May 1st.
- Weekends 9:00 AM, 12:00 AM, 2:30 PM, 5:30 PM in the month of April.
Starting May 1st 9:00 AM, 12:00 AM, 3:00 PM, 6:00 PM.
- Start times may vary for those parks that have lights

Web-site

- The schedule and scores/standings will be maintained and accessible from the North Delta Baseball Assoc web-site, ndbaseball.com

Schedule

- The scheduler will provide a form that each association must complete. This form will aid the scheduler in creating the schedule and setting up the web-site. The team’s schedules, scores and standings will be hosted on the North Delta Baseball Association web-site.
- The schedule may not be symmetrical.
- Regular season games can be moved if both teams agree.
- Playoff games aren’t to be moved.

Reporting Scores

- 13U A | 15U A | 18U AA the home team will email their game results to Steve (scheduler@ndbaseball.com) and Steve will manually enter the scores on SportsEngine (ndbaseball.com). Stream lining the process, no more team pages.
- 13U AA will use GameChanger for their schedule and standings.
 1. Admin (Brent) creates a 13U AA league in GC
 2. Admin adds the schedule to the GC league
 3. Each 13U AA team creates a team in GC. Player stats set to private.
Naming convention for team names: Town | Team Name | 13U AA
Ex. Ladner Red Sox 13U AA, North Delta Rays 13U AA

4. By default the Home Team is the GC scorekeeper
5. Admin will over-ride the game score if there are any issues
6. Admin is to be notified of any game date/time changes. Admin will update the GC schedule to reflect the new date/time.

- Does 18U AA want to use GameChanger in 2026?

Playoffs

- All teams qualify for the playoffs. All teams must participate in the playoffs. No team may blackout any June dates for tournaments. Teams must be available for the playoffs that run for the first couple weeks of June.
- The cut-off date/time for the completion of the regular season games will be communicated to all the teams by the coordinator.
- Regular season standings will be determined by the winning %.
- Tie-breakers will be determined by the 29.01 tie-breaker rules in the BC Minor rulebook.
- The play-off format will typically break each division into 2 tiered pools. A smaller division may not be broken up into 2 pools. Each pool will play in a round robin format with the top two teams playing in a final game. Of the two finalists the team with the best regular season record will be the home team.
- The play-offs are to be complete by Father's Day.

Awards

- Medallions are awarded to the 1st place regular season team.
- Tie-breakers will be determined by the 29.01 tie-breaker rules in the BC Minor rulebook.
- Trophies to be awarded for 1st and 2nd place in each pool for the playoffs

Fees

- Team fees are due before the start of the season. Making the assumption that the trophy/medallions cost will increase by < %5 for 2026.

Suggested 2026 team fees:

18U AA: \$210/team

15U A: \$210/team

13U AA: \$160/team

13U A: \$160/team
