o Jr. Mites/Mites:

- o 26 boys moving up to squirt, 2 possible peer move ups (1 goalie)
- o 8 girls looking to move to U10, but a few they may stay with squirts. There may be a few girls currently on riverblades that are discussing coming to squirts
- Parent meeting happening at the end of the month for mites to squirt parents (march 29th at Husky Den).

o **Squirts:**

- o Great season!
- O There is feedback on the end of the year brackets because they had all B1's and B2's together. It didn't seem right because the B2's didn't feel like they had a chance. Most of the B2's ended up in the consolation bracket anyhow, but they didn't feel like they had a chance to begin with. This is feedback we'd like to provide to D5 organizers. There were only two trophies for 1st and 2nd, nothing for 3rd, which was tougher on the kids.
