



How do I become a Coach with Plymouth Youth Hockey?

The first step to becoming a coach with Plymouth Youth Hockey is to register with USA Hockey and complete their requirements at:

Steps to Become a USA Hockey Coach

USA Hockey and the Coaching Education Program require both certification and registration to be eligible to coach. Registration is done online on a yearly basis.

USA Hockey Requirements (Must be completed before participating in any team activities)

- **Register as a member of USA Hockey.** (Cost is \$46 plus any affiliate fees if applicable). [Click here for more information.](#)
- **Complete the background screening.** [Click here.](#)
- **Complete the USA Hockey Safe Sport Training.** (Required every year and cannot be added to a roster until completed). [Click here for more information.](#)
- **Complete the online age-specific module(s) for the age level of play you are coaching.** (Cost is \$10 per module and only needs to be completed once per age level. Must be completed PRIOR to participating in any team activities and cannot be added to a roster until completed) [Click here to register for the modules.](#)
- **Find, register and attend the required certification clinic.** You can only attend one clinic per season and all coaches start at Level 1. [Click here to locate a clinic.](#)

Confirm your CEP Certification Expiration date is current, respective Age Specific Modules are completed for the level you will be coaching, SafeSport is verified, and Background Screening is verified (Note: the Background Screening is valid for two years). If you need to update anything use the respective links in blue.



What happens next?

- The PYH Coaching Coordinator will validate your credentials with USA Hockey
- All Head Coaches will be interviewed by the Board of Directors prior to selection
- Head Coaches will select their Assistant Coaches
- You will be placed on a PYH Team Roster once you have completed USA Hockey Registration, Safe Sport training, Background Screening, Age Specific Modules, and PYH Registration. **All USA Hockey Coaching Requirements must be completed prior to the start of the PYH Season.** Note: If your CEP Level is expiring on December 31 of this year, you must complete the next Level Class.
