Player's Code of Conduct

As a player in Winter Park Babe Ruth:

- I will remember that games are played for fun!
- I will display good sportsmanship ahead of my own personal desire to win, regardless of the score, by acting in a positive manner.
- I understand that I am only allowed to use bats in games or in practice that are approved by Babe Ruth League for my age division.
- I will show respect to all game officials, coaches, players, and parents and never act in a manner that would be disrespectful toward them.
- I will not throw my helmet or bat or make any other temper related outburst.
- I understand that foul language will not be tolerated.
- I will not use drugs, alcohol or tobacco products at any Winter Park Babe Ruth practice or games.
- I will make every attempt to attend all scheduled practices and games and I will inform the coach if I am unable to attend.
- I will shake hands with all the members of the other team at the conclusion of all games with a positive attitude.
- I will shake hands and thank the officials at the conclusion of all games.

I understand that penalties for violating this Player's Code of Conduct may be imposed upon me by my team manager, divisional commissioner, or the Board of Directors of Winter Park Babe Ruth

Dependant on the nature of the infraction:

1st Offense; or ejected from a game; or using an illegal bat – 1 game suspension;

2nd Offense – 2 game suspension;

3rd Offense – Suspension for a prescribed period of time as determined by the Board of Directors of Winter Park Babe Ruth.
