Shoulder Surgery Helps Teen Hockey Player Win State Title

After a complex surgery on both shoulders, Giuliana Lufty is back on the ice and competing once again.

"Hockey is one of my favorite things to do," says Giuliana, a junior at University Liggett School in Grosse Pointe Woods. "It's almost like a release from everything that's going on. To just be out there and not have to worry about anything except the game that you're playing."

Unfortunately, several years ago a persistent shoulder injury threatened to sideline Giuliana. For years, Giuliana tried to find answers and went to several specialists. Meanwhile, she powered through the pain. Finally, before the end of her freshman year, Giuliana was referred to Vasilios Moutzouros, M.D., Henry Ford Sports Medicine orthopedic surgeon.
