Reporting to the Associate Director, Athletics & Recreation, the Head Coach's responsibilities with the Women's Volleyball Program will include:

- Developing and implementing an annual training program that maximizes recruiting opportunities, optimizes training sessions, and prepares the student-athletes for success in CCAA competition
- Providing appropriate physical and mental training programs
- Supporting and monitoring student-athletes' academic progress
- Integrating community programming with the Women's Volleyball Program
- Designing and running grassroots clinics and camps
- Supporting and acting in accordance to the strategic direction and initiatives as they relate to student- athlete support, general promotions, budget management, appropriate administrative responsibilities, and community/alumni relations
- Leading the program in accordance to Niagara College, OCAA, and CCAA policies and procedures

The successful candidate should have a diploma or degree in a related field and have a minimum of four years of relevant experience. A minimum full certification at the NCCP Level 2 (or equivalent) is required. Previous coaching experience in the CCAA, USPORT and/or Elite Club level is considered an asset.

Salary range will be up to \$29,000-38,000 dependent upon education and experience.
