Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the April meeting were approved.

General Update - Chris Johnson

- Brad Kaplan Approved as Field Coordinator
 - Chris motioned to approve
 - o Gary Seconded it
- Insurance update
 - All team insurance policies have been completed and provided to each team
 - Umbrella policy still in the works
- Grant for lights at a field, not sure if locals will approve. Maybe at WJH
 - o If we decide to go through with it. Nobody wants Guilliams lit due to retirement community. They are re-doing West Junior High and maybe able to work with the city as they are re-doing the facility.
 - We could move toward using West Junior high as our primary field.
 - We could move away from Eisenhower.
 - Discussed moving in with Legion for the funding.
 - We are committed to a dollar amount as we use it quite a bit.
 - Need to get neighborhoods to buy in even though the lights don't give off a lot of ambient light.
 - We most likely won't be able to light Guilliams field.
- Fire station won't be available after December 2018.
 - Next option is to use Hopkins Pavilion

Financial Reporting – Brenda Campbell

- Monthly financials
 - o \$74k in bank
 - \$4k in tractor and field equipment
- Bank accounts
 - We have two different banks
 - Discussed moving down to 1st Minnetonka
 - Need to check on which account Sports Engine uses
- Actual revenue
 - \$85k over budget
- Travel registration
 - Not all players have paid for \$8k
- Senior registration

 - Not as many limits on bats including USAAA and USA.
 - o Confirmed we are insured with USAAA
 - o VOTE
 - Should we permit our players to use USAAA bats?
 - Matt If the goal is to win, we have a better chance with USAAA bats.

- Chris Motion to use either the USA or USSSA bats for USSSA Only tournaments
- Brenda We need to be competitive and there are no liability issues
- All in favor, the vote passes.

Scheduling Jayson Olson and Dave Stuessi

- Any umpire issues?
 - Had some issues in the early season but doing better now
- Have a shortage of umpires for all Regions & Leagues
 - Are working to secure additional HBA umpires
 - o Should we provide a "pillow" protector, we have plenty of shin guards and masks
- General update

Fields Update – Brad Kaplan and Dave Stuessi

- General update
- Field updates:
 - o Bullpen backstop fence on 1B side installed
 - All canopies have been put up
 - Bullpen turf has been added, home plates have been painted
 - Mounds
 - Discussed moving mound up for 13/14 year old players
 - Tough to do in the middle of the season
 - Move up one foot
 - Discussed removable mound (rubber) using similar posts as we do for the bases. Cap the hole like a base.
 - Pitching machine
 - Jerry We need to use a new one that can be programmed which can be expensive (\$5k)
 - We can find one on eBay but they go fast and tend to bid high
 - o Guilliams 13U pitching mound should be moved up 1-foot
 - o All combination locks have been changed, new lock for storage room
 - Storage locks
 - Changed code and would like to get lockers where we can put a combination code
 - Seeking approval for locker
 - \$75 each
 - Vote: Purchase two lockers by vending machine or equipment area
 - Jerry seconded it
 - Vote passes
 - Seeking approval to purchase a long power cord for the pitching machine, ear muffs & safety glasses
 - Need 50 foot cord
 - Vending machine purchase have been made
 - Need to confirm cash in amounts
- Vote: Approve field workers to do field prep during the week
 - Vote passed
 - Brenda to leave checks in shed for workers on a bi-weekly basis
- First aid kits
 - Jerry This replaces the small kits illustrating Kramer kits for \$80
 - We need to check Guilliams equipment shed to confirm whether we have any in stock
 - o Discussed keeping one at each field in a storage container and need one for travel games.
 - o Replacement parts can be purchased

- Ice packs
 - We have three boxes purchased at Universal Equipment
- Amazon offers
 - Good equipment for lower cost at \$26.95
 - Gary Kemp shared the kit he purchased for \$17 but it is smaller than we might need
 - Other options is to purchase tackle boxes and fill with needed materials
 - Triangle bandage, splints
 - However if player breaks an arm, the best bet is to send them to the doctor
- Next steps
 - Chris to purchase \$26.95 kit to ensure we have room for ice packs
 - Jerry to look for a robust kit for Guilliams field
- Vote: Upgrade coaches first aid kit not to exceed \$
 - Gary makes the motion
 - Brenda seconds motion
 - Vote passes

Sr. League Update – Jenny Kemp and Gary Kemp

- General update
- Pitch count rules need to be adhered to
 - o 16U
 - Maximum 95 pitches per game
 - o 17 19U
 - Maximum of 105 pitches per game
 - Days of rest
 - 1-29 pitches 0 days
 - 30-49 pitches 1 day
 - 50-69 pitches 2 days
 - 70 89 pitches 3 days
 - 90 or more 4 days
 - Penalties
 - 1st offense Head coach suspension for remainder of game played and the next game
 - 2nd offense Head coach suspension for the remainder of game and remainder of season
 - Pitch count recording completed for opposing team by head coach on myas.org.
- Guilliams field for practices
 - Booked up through June
 - o However if it is open on the weekend, book it through dibs
