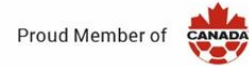

Ontario Soccer is pleased to announce the date and location of upcoming Coach Development opportunities. Please see below for course details and registration information.

B License Part 1 Course

Ontario Soccer is currently accepting applications for the B License Part 1 course, set to take place on:

- June 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28 (5 consecutive weekdays)

This course will be held in Ottawa, Ontario, at Millennium Sports Park. Upon applying, coaches will be provided with further details regarding location, times, etc.

The B License Part 1 course is designed to educate the candidates in the practical and theoretical developments in modern soccer, so that they may devise, organize, conduct and evaluate coaching sessions in basic and advanced skills, tactics, strategies, and systems of play. Candidates will also better understand and employ the complimentary managerial, medical, and coach-related aspects, appropriate to the role of the coach at the competitive level.

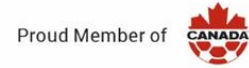
It is aimed at coaches working with players in an environment where they are still learning, with some importance given to the result, without sacrificing complete player development. Coaches should be coaching in a competitive environment, as defined by the Canada Soccer Player Pathway.

The requirements for coaches to apply to the B License Part 1 course are that they must provide proof of: completion of their full C License **AND** Make Ethical Decisions, Respect in Sport, and Making Head Way in Soccer.

Applications can be submitted via **Coach Centre**. Once a coach's application has been approved, they will be granted access to register for this course.

The deadline to register for the course is **Thursday, May 23, 2019**. Please ensure you have completed your registration no later than **3:00 p.m.** on this date.

C License Course

Ontario Soccer is currently accepting registration for the C License course, set to take place on:

- May 25, 26, and June 1, 2, 2019

This course will be held in Richmond Hill, Ontario, at Richmond Hill Crosby Heights YMCA Centre. Upon applying, coaches will be provided with further details regarding location, times, etc.

The focus of the C License is on the individual player in the different contexts of the game, as we try to develop their decision making and build their level of execution. Coaches learn to develop their sessions based on their players and their developmental objectives. They learn to devise, organize, conduct, and evaluate coaching sessions in basic skills, tactics, and strategies.

It is aimed at coaches working with players who are starting, or still learning and developing, as players. Coaches should be coaching in a competitive environment, as defined by the Canada Soccer Player Pathway.

The requirements for coaches to apply to the C License course are that they must provide proof of: completion of the Learn to Train **OR** Soccer for Life course(s) **AND** Make Ethical Decisions, Respect in Sport, and Making Head Way in Soccer.

Applications can be submitted via **Coach Centre**. Once a coach's application has been approved, they will be granted access to register for this course.

The deadline to register for the course is **Wednesday, May 1, 2019**. Please ensure you have completed your registration no later than **3:00 PM** on this date.
