

HOST SITE REQUIREMENTS:

When requesting to host Coach certification clinics hosts must be able to meet the following requirements:

Facilities should have a multi-purpose/meeting room suitable for **30-35 people** for the classroom session.

We ask the hosts to have a good supply of pucks and pylons for all sessions. We will bring all necessary electronics with us but we require the host provide a screen or a white wall to project on. If the host has a LCD projector available that would be preferred.

Coach 1 and Coach 2

Require **4 hours of classroom time and 1 hour of ice** immediately following the classroom. The standard format for a clinic typically looks like the following:

- Weekend Clinic Classroom from 9:00am 1:00pm and Ice from 1:00pm 2:00pm
- Weekday Evening Clinic Classroom from 5:00pm 9:00pm and Ice from 9:00pm 10:00pm

Development 1

Require 2 days (Saturday & Sunday) to complete, each day running from 9:00am – 5:00pm. The standard format looks like the

- Classroom from 9:00am 12:00pm
- Lunch from 12:00pm 1:00pm
- On-Ice from 1:00pm 2:00pm
- Classroom from 2:00pm 5:00pm

Checking Skills 1

Require <u>2 hour classroom</u> and <u>1 hour of ice</u> format which looks like the following:

- Weekend Clinic Classroom from 10:00am 12:00pm and ice from 12:00pm 1:00pm
- Weekday Evening Clinic Classroom from 6:00pm 8:00pm and ice from 8:00pm 9:00pm

^{**}A host must meet further requirements in order to be eligible for a Development 1 clinic**



HOW TO REQUEST A CLINIC:

When requesting Coach certification clinics you must provide the following information to your Regional representative that is responsible for booking clinics:

- Clinic Type
- Facility (including classroom location and ice location)
- Date
- Start time for classroom session
- Start time for on-ice session

Once the clinic has been confirmed, online registration will be set up on eHockey. A direct link will be sent to the Regions to be passed on to the Minor Hockey Associations. We open clinics up to all registered coaches in the province but your Minor Hockey Association will have first priority.

The clinics require a minimum of 10 participants and will be capped at a maximum of 30 participants.

PLEASE NOTE: Clinics that do not meet the minimum requirement of attendees may be subject to cancellation two days prior to the clinic date. Participants signed up for the clinic will be notified via email if the clinic is cancelled.
