ATTENDANCE FOR ALL PRACTICES AND GAMES IS MANDATORY!

Attendance Policy

1 unexcused = sit $\frac{1}{4}$ game

2 unexcused = $\frac{1}{2}$ game

3 unexcused = sit $\frac{1}{2}$ of 2 different games

4 unexcused CANNOT CHEER AT COMPETITION

1 unexcused game = 2 unexcused absences'

3 late arrivals or early dismissals = 1 unexcused

10 minutes late arrival to assigned game time = sit $\frac{1}{4}$ game

Arrival or Dismissal of 30 minutes or more will be considered an absence.
