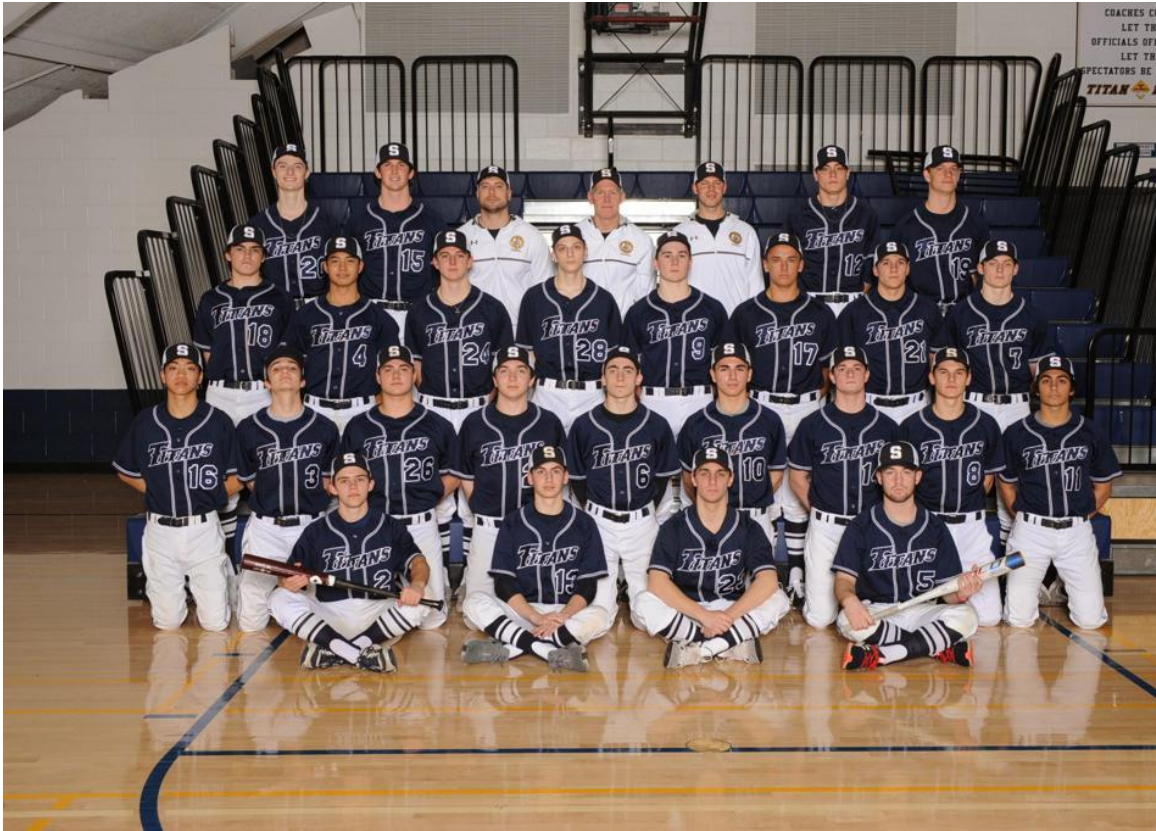


Boys & Girls Track

Sailing Club

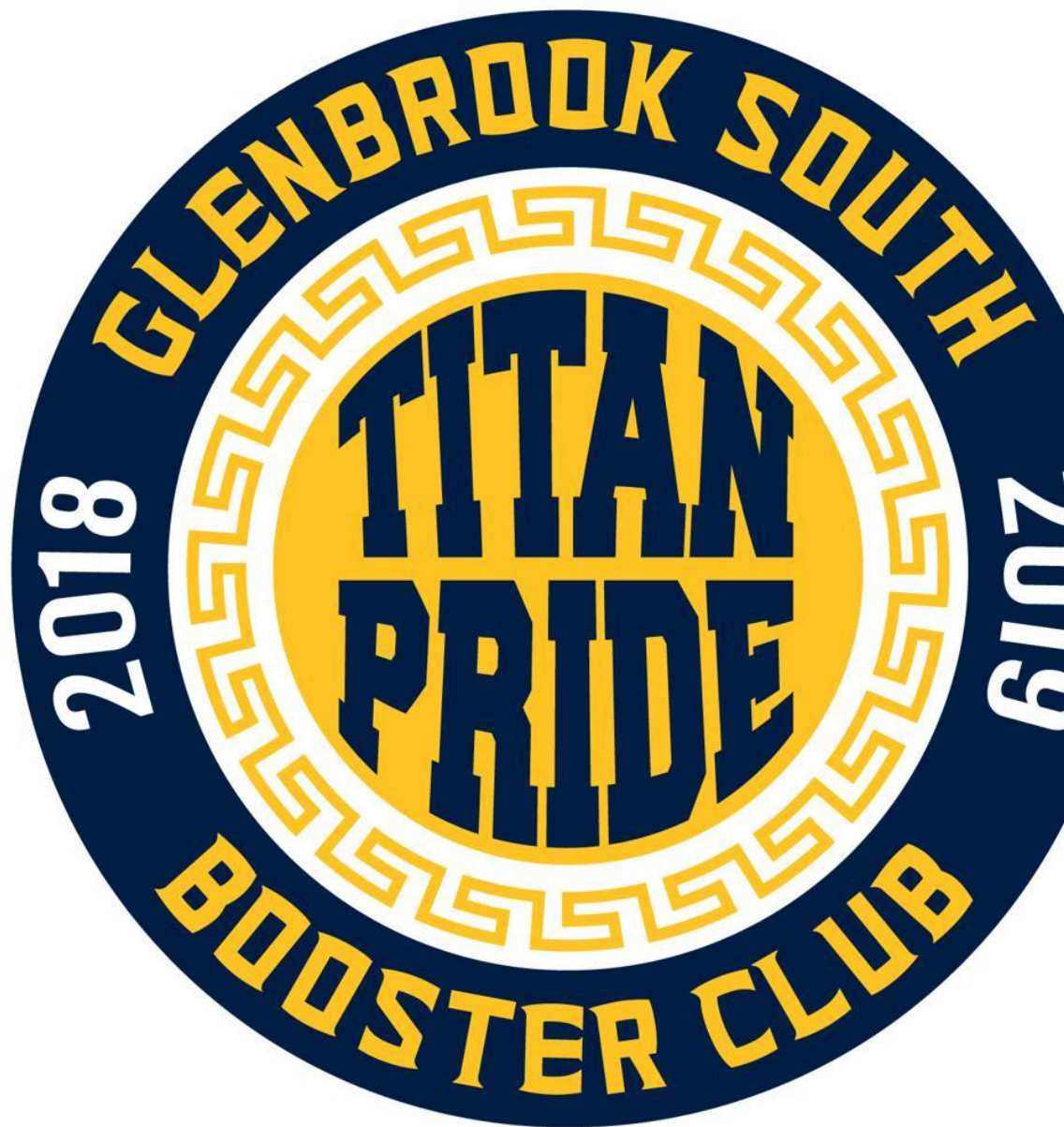
The GBS Sailing Team begins its Spring racing season in April!

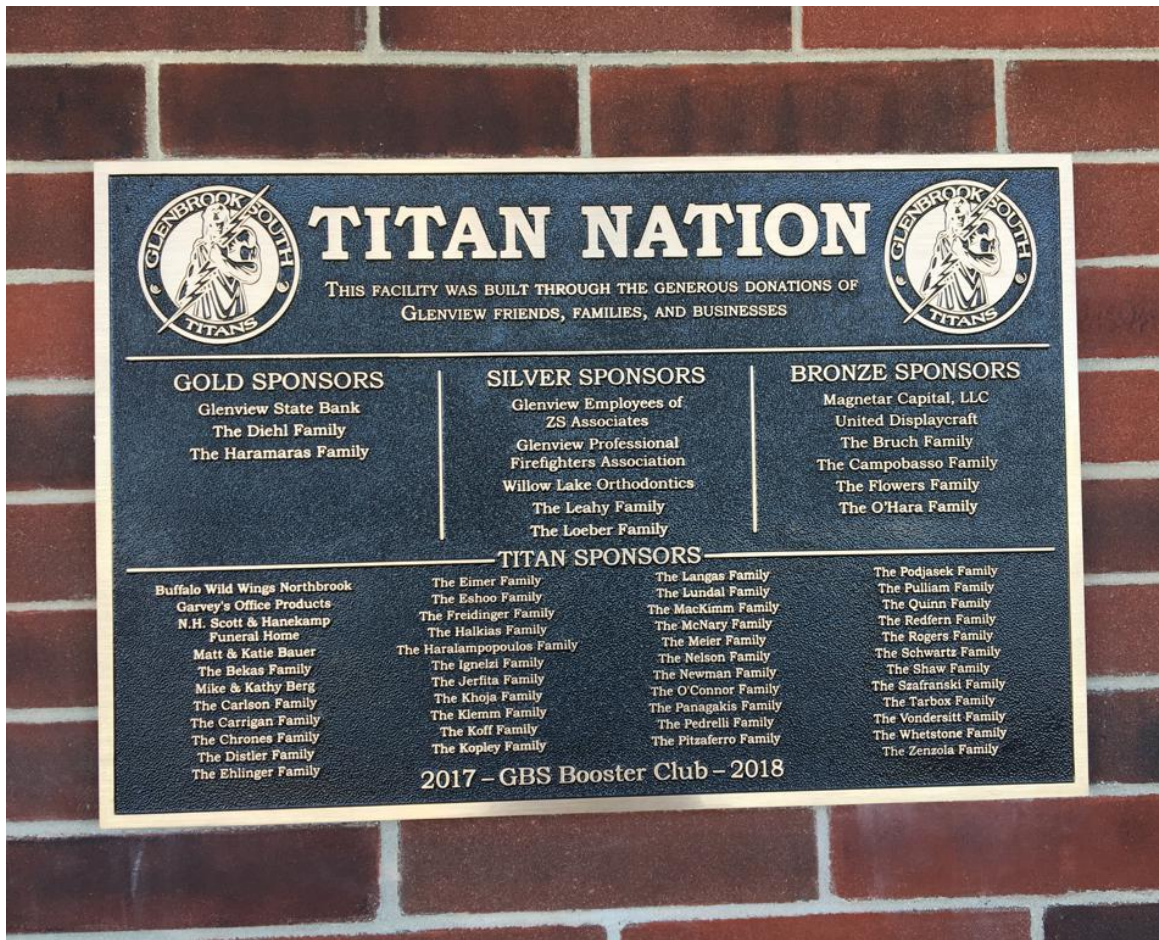
