#### Squirts:

 Would like to recommend the Fargo tournament again this year. Has only seen one email so far for tournaments. Talked about having our top tier teams, recommended to get as many teams there that we can. Typically open up July 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### o <u>Peewees:</u>

 Reviewing feedback from last year on tournaments to help determine what ones to register for upon opening up.

#### o **Bantams**:

- o Troy is the new lead travel coordinator.
- o Looking to be consistent with the same tournaments they had last year.
- Goalie situation for Bantams we are looking to have 3 and potentially 4 for this coming year.

#### o Girls:

- 10 week session for the girls during the summer Sunday/Monday night skate. About 45 girls have registered already. For incoming 10U girls. This is on Facebook and emails have gone out. Looking to add power skating to the Monday night.
- o Looking for coaches, lost a few from last year due to moving and change in family situations. There is some good movement on potential coaches.

 Looking to have a traveling coach to help work with the teams and coaches throughout the year. Still evaluating this.

# **Goalie Coordinators Report (Jeff/Matt/Tanner):**

- O Clinics start June 9<sup>th</sup>. Sent the communication to all of the goalies that he is aware of.
- o Invite the Riverblade girls to come to this clinic. Tanner will send Craig the information for the clinic.
- o Equipment has been ordered.
- o Tanner to send the communication for the clinic to all of the coordinators.
- Would like to set up a 'goalie corner' / space on the SCYHA website, stretches, clinic dates, tips, etc.

#### **Old Business:**

- Review EB and BOD Election appointments training is starting for new appointments
- Junior Gold nothing new at this time Kurt to reach out to the new ED for St. Cloud to advocate to look at this. Look at providing education for parents and players.
- Baseline concussion testing Jenna Binsfeld working with Williams Integricare to
  partner with them for this. SCYHA will pay for this, highly recommended for Peewees
  and Bantams, looking to offer before Dynamics.
- Logo looking to come to the June meeting with 3 offers to vote on, if we would like to switch it.

#### **New Business:**

- Body contact clinic: Jared is getting more information on Fancisco Hockey to present options. Sessions for peewee's and bantams.
- Summer ice times:

- Ice opened up previous ice/camp was removed. Do we want to use this for the K and Pre-K, do we want to run this program through SCYHA? There are a few options that we can look into. The ice time is available now. 3 hours per day for 3 weeks. End of July/early august
- Mid/Later summer PEP camp we will be doing something like this again. This will be our second year doing this.
- Early season PEP fundraiser camp helps to offset the cost of the equipment and programming.
- Age-Level coordinators
  - Numbers & Tournaments please bring this to the next meeting, June. \*\*Can we do declaration at the June meeting, include this in the reminder for the meeting.
- Scholarships reviewed the recipients.

#### **Open Forum:**

- o Proposed to move to a flat fee for next year? Do we want to change this to a flat amount/fixed rate for dues. Positives it is fixed and it is easy to plan and parents know what they are looking at from the year. Teams would be able to eliminate their checking accounts. There are some teams that haven't refunded their teams yet, so if we did a flat amount, this would not happen next year. Some of the challenges would be that there wouldn't be as much flexibility for parties and gifts, etc. Not sure how the non-parent coaches would be accounted for. The girls do this, and it works very well. Refs?? How do they pay for this? Can we account for X amount of refs throughout the year. For the ref's in D10, they want a check at the time of the scrimmage. This is for scrimmages only. Check out what this looks like for the girls, explore how it works. Sara Yurczyk will do some more research into how others structure this.
- Tanner would like to have the team coaches at the goalie clinics to help them learn and take some of these skills to their practices throughout the season. Can we communicate this more to the coaches or make it a requirement? Yes, we will encourage this for the coaches.
- O Steve Karol to have this available for the coaches. Tanner to run with this.
- USA Hockey now has goalie levels for coaches.
