#### **CBHA Financial Update:**

- We are currently in the 20% refund bracket until January. The percentages are based on non recoverable costs.
- Academy spots have been refunded at 100%
- There will be no back fill for spots
- Potential refund/credit at the end of the season for all players depending on the duration of the entire season. Will be the entire program not just individual players and teams.

# **Updated COVID Rules:**

- Updated masking and locker room protocols. Only skates and helmets in locker rooms and no coaching in locker rooms.
- Quarantine timeframe for Casco Bay Hockey Assoc is now 10 days. Which puts its in line with the Maine CDC quidelines. Players are unable to test out of quarantine.

#### Casco Bay Arena:

- CBHA travel will be pausing the saturday after Christmas. Tier 4 will be taking a full weekend after Christmas.
- Schedules are only done through December 2020

#### **Questions/Discussion:**

- CBHA's goal is to extend the season into April
- Kids skating 2.5-3 times a week until we are able to practice fully
- CBA is the priority to fill the ice over our other home rinks
- Mites original cohorts are to large for the current 30 person capacity. Potentially dividing into 2 groups that way players will get 1.5 hours with current ice allotment. A single coach would run both sessions using the same practice plan. Coaches/Directors will communicate out to parents.
