

TRYOUT WEEK

If your player is unable to tryout this week due to injury or other reasons, you must contact Coach Juntunen in advance. Players can be given a chance to be evaluated and placed on a team or cut at a later date given the circumstances merit this option.

MONDAY 3/16 DAY 1: All groups will have tryout evaluations

TUESDAY 3/17 DAY 2: All groups will have tryout evaluations

WEDNESDAY 3/18 DAY 3: Varsity/JV group will have further evaluations. 9th grade and Sophomores meet with coaches about team placement, cuts.

THURSDAY 3/19 DAY 4: Team practices and gear handout. JV and Varsity cuts made.

FRIDAY 3/20 DAY 5: Team practices and gear handout, team meetings (9th Grade and Bsquad)





First 3 Weeks

Week of March 16th (Tryout Week): Turf and gym space in 2025 from 3 pm - 6 pm, hoping for roughly the same time frame.

Week of March 23rd: 9th grade practice at Salk 3 pm - 5 pm. Bsquad and Varsity/JV group could practice any time between 3-8 pm for a 2 hour practice. Will depend on gym/turf schedule prepared by AD.

Week of March 30th (Spring Break): 9th grade practice at Salk 3 pm - 5 pm (outside if fields are ready) Bsquad and Varsity/JV group could practice any time between 3-8 pm unless outside. Will depend on gym/turf schedule prepared by AD. Returning 2025 Bsquad and Varsity/JV players in Florida (pending final commitments).





Spring Break Policy

Practices will be held over Spring Break. Players that choose to attend a family trip and miss any portion of practice will sit the first game of the season. This is program wide.





Playing Levels We Offer

- 9th grade: 9A we would look to add 9B if we have enough registered. 12-15 at this level for one team 11-13 per team if we have two.
- B Squad: 10th grade level, some 9th graders could be brought up to this level. 12-15 at this level.
- Varsity/JV: Practice together, we will typically keep 25-27 players here. Could consist of all grade levels.





Summer Baseball Opportunities

VFW - 9th and 10th graders

<u>Junior Legion</u> - 9th, 10th and 11th graders (birthdate dependent)

<u>Senior Legion</u> – outgoing seniors and top players in the program

- *20-30 games, depending on playoff success
- VFW and Senior Legion for sure, goal is to also have Junior Legion each summer
- *Goal is 12-14 rostered, committed players. Sr. Legion may carry more players
- *More information will be available as we get closer to the HS season.





Equipment and Team Apparel


- Every other year is the goal, 2026 trip pending School Board approval on 11/10.

- We need parent help to make these trips happen!






Elk River High School Dugout Club

- Various equipment requests submitted but not guaranteed



Dugout Club Income/Fundraising Sources:


- **Sponsorship:** \$25,000 sponsorship drive goal for 2026







- Dates: Mon, 3/30/26 Fri, 4/3/26
- Location: St. Petersburg, Florida
 - Tampa Bay Spring Training Facility
 - Bilmar Beach Resort
 - Pending 11/10 School Board approval

2026 Spring Training Trip Financial View

Projected Trip Expenses (subject to change) - Approximately \$1,995/person total cost

- Sun Country Airfare: approximately \$630/person
 - Contract fee: \$50
 - Includes one checked bag and assigned seat/person
 - \$60 non-refundable, per person deposit due within 7 days of booking (applied to total group payment)
 - Final payment due 60 days prior to departure
- Tampa Bay Training Center Pkg: \$1132/person (player or coach)
 - Tampa Bay Training Registration Fee: \$250
 - Total payment due 30 days prior to start of trip
- MN airport transportation: 2024 cost approx. \$600
- Florida ground transportation: 2024 cost was approx. \$1500/van (potentially need 3)
- Additional fees to account for: van gasoline, any additional meals (Tampa Bay provides 2 meals/day starting with breakfast day after arrival and ending with breakfast day of departure), team activity(ies), additional baggage fees
