- **Motion did not pass:**
 - Approve: 6
 - Oppose: 11
- Tamara Rozmarynowski **motioned** to approve the primary and alternate jersey/uniform as designed and proposed to the GYS board by Fox Cities Embrodiary.
- Rachel Sommers **seconded motion. Motion approved by majority (18 approve).**
- Mark Lund **motioned** that 7U-12U would all use the Primary jersey. 9U-12U has the option to purchase the alternate jersey/uniform as second jersey/uniform.
- Dave Much **seconded motion. Motion passed by majority (18 approve)**
- 7U - 9U boys and 8U girls tournament team tryouts (March 20). COVID rules – limit to one parent/guardian per player trying out.
 - 8U girls are all set. Will be in 2 groups starting at 8:30 a.m.
 - 7U baseball – no tryouts
 - 8U baseball (2 p.m. – 4 p.m.) – currently 22 registered. Will split into two randomized groups for tryouts.
 - 9U baseball (11 a.m. – 2 p.m.) – currently at 29 registered. Will split into two randomized groups for tryouts.
- SCHEELS partnership update – Pat Wetzel
 - SCHEELS event date(s): April 10 (need 4-5 volunteers).
 - Schedule:
 - 8:30 a.m. – Volunteers arrive
 - Pat will work with league commissioners to assign leagues to specific times for jersey handout.
 - We may have fewer teams than sponsors/jerseys. Pat will need to be included in the conversation when teams are formed so he can assign teams to sponsors.
- Concession stand update – Darin/Amanda
 - Floor is painted. Walls are painted. Cabinets and countertops are installed. Two TVs are installed. WiFi will be available this week. Next steps is to get the POS system up and running (Amanda is working on).

- Sponsorship/Fundraising update – Pat Wetzel
 - Working on banners. Water bottles.
 - Timber Rattlers has expressed interest in sponsoring something.
 - All World Ford has expressed interest in sponsoring GYS.
- Calendar Raffle update – Pat Wetzel
 - Calendars are printed and available. We will be setting up locations, times and days for pickup. Pickup should be available at Town Hall and Jeff’s Water Conditioning (salt bay) anytime.
 - Sales incentives will still be available (through FCE and SCHEELS gift cards).
- Tournament team sponsorships – agree that donations need to be submitted to GYS (the org as a non-profit) and the board can/will determine allocation of donation funds. If a donor specifies that they want the funds to be allocated to a specific team the board still needs to be involved in that discussion to be sure funds are allocated appropriately and are not putting our non-profit status at risk.

- 2021 Policies & Procedures (updated draft attached to meeting) – GYS, Baseball Tournament Team Policies & Procedures will be in a clean, final format and presented to the board for vote/approval at the April board meeting.
- Spring Training Day

 - May 9 – Softball (Looking at 9 teams total participating).
 - Need to figure out umpires (would be a good opportunity to do some training)
 - Send any volunteer needs to Lori so that they can be set up in Dibs.
- Summer help
 - Concession stand
 - Lead: Brooke O’Connor (18 years old. Has worked in the concession stand for 3 years.
 1. Rachel Sommer motioned to approve hiring Brooke as the lead in the Concessions stand for the summer of 2021.
 2. Mark Lund seconded motion. Motion approved (16 approved).
 - There are also five others interested in working in the concession stand.
 - Wages: Lead @ \$13/hour, additional employees: \$11/hour (over 18 w/liquor license), \$10/hour (over 18), 1st year: \$8/hour, 2nd year: \$9/hour, 3rd year: \$9.50
 1. Pat Wetzel **motioned** to approve the wages as proposed.
 2. Greg Reimann **seconded** motion. **Motion approved.**
 - Field crew
 - Wages: 1st year: \$10/hour, 2nd year: \$12/hour
 - Darin is working on potential hires.

- Golf outing – possible date: Aug. 14. Ryan will check with Winnegamie. Darin will check with a few other golf courses. Lori also offered to help with planning.
- Darin and Pat have a meeting tomorrow (3/4/21) with the Town and the Civic Club.
- Equipment – Lanny Rogers
 - Lanny and Darin developed a list of equipment needs for GYS.
 - Needs listed in priority order:
 1. Fencing items - \$430
 2. L-screens (3) - \$654
 3. Chalking machines (2) - \$600
 4. Paint stripper = \$160
 5. Batter’s box template & measuring tape - \$325

Total: \$2179
 - Mark Lund motioned to approve the equipment purchases as mentioned, not to exceed \$2,500.
 - Greg Reimann seconded motion. Motion approved.

 - Dave Much **seconded motion.**
