



IMPORTANT NEW POLICIES & PROCEDURES

We are excited to get everyone back skating, however, the health and safety of our guests remains our top priority. With that, we have implemented a series of new mandatory policies and procedures that must be followed. The purpose of these measures is to promote the health of all our guests, athletes, coaches, and staff through a safe return under certain controlled conditions to prevent the spread of coronavirus.

The policies will be strictly enforced. Please familiarize yourself with the policies below and help us have a successful reopening:

1. **Arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the scheduled clinic time.** Participants will be allowed to enter the building exactly 15 minutes prior to the scheduled clinic time and must exit immediately following the completion of the session. To avoid congregating at the front doors, please wait in your car until your entry time.
2. **One parent / guardian may accompany any children under 18.** We kindly ask that they leave the building once the skaters are on the ice.
3. **Players are to arrive dressed in their hockey equipment. No hockey bags are allowed in facility.**
4. **Players will check-in at table outside main entrance.** Each skater will receive a number at check in that corresponds to a chair in the lobby to put your skates on and take skates off. Skaters will be escorted to their chair by a staff member and asked to remain in their chair until they are instructed to enter the ice.
5. **Masks are required for everyone entering the building and must be worn at all time other than when on the ice.** Employees will also be wearing masks. Everyone will be asked to practice physical social distancing by standing at least six feet from other groups of people.
6. **Players must bring their own water bottle, filled and labeled with their names.** Water fountains will not be available.

We are constantly monitoring the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, government mandates and public health advancements and will continue to update our protocols and procedures, as necessary.

We appreciate your cooperation in following the strict guidelines so we can continue to operate during these times and provide various clinics and programs for you and your peers.
