▶ WHERE?

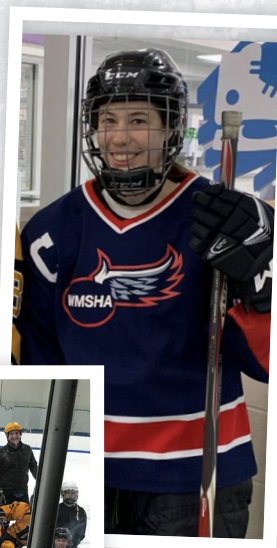

Once a week from October through March

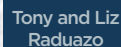
