Dear Potential Texas Jr Stars Supporter,

The Texas Jr Stars Bantam AA hockey team is comprised of "advanced" players born in 2004 and 2005 from all over the Austin Texas area. The Stars compete at the high level of hockey in Texas and also participate in other out of state Tournaments.

Our Stars Teams in Austin are run as independent teams with no local support or subsidies from our Minor Hockey Associations. Our total operating budgets must be fulfilled by parent contributions and generous donations and sponsorship from our local community businesses. The average budget to operate a team in the Greater Austin Area playing and practicing out of the local rinks (Chapparal Ice and The Pond Hockey Club) throughout the 2018-2019 season will be in excess of \$80,000 (with the majority of those costs being related to ice time and tournaments).

As a team we have taken on the task of fundraising to help minimize the individual player's costs. Our focus is to ensure that every player has the ability to play at the highest competitive level as possible regardless of their family background/situation.

This year as a team we will attend two tournaments in Dallas and another Tournament in Colorado. Last year, our team came so close to qualifying for a fourth Tournament in Canada. Our wonderful coach would like to continue to showcase our team this year at additional out of state tournament. This tournament will be in addition to what our standard season costs are.

At this time we ask for your generosity and support of this very worthwhile program. Your kind donation or sponsorship will be used to offset the expenditures for our players concerning travel, practices, and games helping our boys develop as players and young men.

ABOUT THE AMHA

The AMHA is the governing body over the youth hockey program in Austin, TX. The AMHA is a nonPprofit organization and should a tax exemption be required, we can take donations or serve as an intermediary. Note that per tax law, all nonPprofits must retain some portion of any direct donation to the organization so that it does not turn into a pass through tax loophole. The AMHA will retain 15% of all donations towards operating costs, scholarships, or fee reduction at our sole discretion.

The Austin Metro Hockey Association (AMHA) is a youth organization operating the Texas Junior Stars and Texas Rising Stars, which offers all levels of play for young people from 8 to 18 years of age. Sponsorships, Donations, and Team Fundraising Sponsorships

Sponsorships:

A sponsorship will be considered any contribution, Cash or Equipment, which REQUIRES A COPY of AMHA's 501(c) (3) letter. Any use of the sponsor's logo or the use of the AMHA logo, letters, or name must be AMHA Board approved. Please refer to the attached 2018-2019 sponsorship opportunities for sponsorship levels.

- 1. Sponsorships are preferred to be directed to the organization as a whole to keep down the cost of hockey for all players
- 2. Sponsorships can be directed to a given team but not a specific player. The funds will be allocated as follows: 85% of the sponsorship amount will go to the team, and 15% will go to the AMHA organization to be used for operating costs, scholarships, or fee reduction at AMHA sole discretion. All funds for the team must be equally distributed to the benefit of all players on the team.
- 3. ALL sponsorship checks should be made out to AMHA and the organization will in turn promptly create a Team Fund to the appropriate team, taking out the AMHA percentage.

Donations:

A donation is cash or equipment contribution to a team in which a 501(c) (3) letter is NOT REQUIRED. Any use of a sponsor's logo or AMHA logo, letters or name must be AMHA Board approved.

Fundraisers:

A fundraiser is considered any team organized event and includes: team raffles, silent auctions, car washes, scratch-off cards, family support banners, Car hops, garage sales or any other item sold by a team to raise money.

- 1. All donations and proceeds from team fundraisers will go 100% to the team fund.
- 2. Any team organized event (e.g. silent auction or raffle) must receive Board approval 30 days in advance. Teams should plan these events in other months as not to conflict with any AMHA activities.
