UNIFORMS





The organization is proud to offer one-of-a-kind jerseys and custom equipment offerings, helping to create a sense of pride in how our players look, both on and off the ice. It is your responsibility to maintain the appearance of your players' uniforms throughout the season.

Our first Uniform & Jersey Fitting day is scheduled for Wednesday, August 2nd, from 5:00pm to 8:00pm, at Jerry's Hockey - Mount Prospect inside Nicholas Sportsplex. If your player has practice or pre-tryout skates, please attend the fitting prior to taking the ice. Also please bring shoulder pads and hockey pants/girdles to the fitting.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

JERSEYS & SOCKS

- Please check your Player's Jerseys NOW to ensure they'll fit for the upcoming season.
- For players new to Chargers, or current players who need a replacement set, they must attend the jersey fitting session to ensure uniforms arrive by the start of the fall season. Please see the website for the uniform fitting dates.
- If the player has a set of game jerseys from last season that still fit and are in presentable condition, they may use that set again this year. Returning players may use last year's game socks only if they are not discolored or ripped. Socks are on sale all season at Jerry's Hockey. Light blue knit socks will be provided to rostered players to be worn at practice.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Jersey numbers are assigned by year of birth.
 Odd birth years have odd numbers, even birth years use even numbers. Numbers chosen at the jersey fittings are based on availability. No exceptions.

HELMETS

- All players will be required to wear a navy blue helmet.
- Helmet stickers will be issued at the start of the season and are to be applied following the NWC Helmet Sticker Guide. No other stickers are permitted on helmets.

GLOVES

- All players will be required to wear navy blue gloves.
- All players on a CSDHL team will be required to wear custom Northwest Chargers Bauer gloves.

HOCKEY PANTS/SHELLS

- All players will be required to wear navy blue pants.
- All Squirt through Midget players will be required to wear the custom Northwest Chargers shell.

EQUIPMENT BAGS

All players on a CSDHL team will be required to have a custom Northwest Chargers equipment bag.

CUSTOM BAUER WARM-UPS

- Bauer Warm-Ups (jacket & pants) are optional at the Mite level.
- Bauer Warm-Ups (jacket & pants) will be required for all Squirt, Pee Wee, and Bantam players.
- Bauer Warm-Up jackets are required for all Midget players.

JERSEY FITTING FAQS

Why are jersey fittings prior to tryouts and team selections?

This ensures timely delivery to ensure the players have jerseys for the start of the season. The Chargers high-quality, Athletic Knit Jerseys are Customized for each player, which takes time to produce.

How does my player select their jersey number?

Player's numbers are selected at the fitting based on their Birth Year and Number Availability.

Birth Year: Players born in Even Numbered years (ex. 2014, 2012, etc.) will select an Even Number based on availability. Players born in Odd Numbered years (ex. 2015, 2013, etc.) will select an Odd Number based on availability. This format helps ensure that players' numbers do not overlap at any given age level.

No exceptions to this rule.

Number Availability: Jersey Number Boards displayed at the fittings list all current Charger Players and their numbers and show the available numbers at each birth year. Open numbers are selected on a "First Come" Basis – Numbers will not be held and cannot be requested.

What if my player does not make a team, will I be issued a refund?

Yes. If your player is not selected for a 2023-2024 team, Jerry's Hockey will refund your money. Payment is expected at fittings which also secures your players' number.

My player's socks are still in good shape from last year do I need to purchase a new pair?

No. As long as there are no cuts, tears, or visible wear and tear you can use your socks from the previous season. We want all of our players to look their best when they take the ice for the Chargers!

We cannot make the Fitting Date, what are our options?

We strongly encourage you to attend the First Fitting Date. This will help ensure your Player's Jerseys are ready for the upcoming start of the season and their preferred number.

HELMET STICKERS

Team Managers will distribute helmet stickers at the start of the season. Also please remove ALL previous Charger-designated stickers, including the Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma Ribbon and the 40th Anniversary Sticker. REMOVE ALL other decals/stickers from your helmet, (non-Chargers approved stickers, Hockey Camp Stickers, etc). The Head Coach will enforce this policy. Do NOT remove the Certified Hockey Helmet & HECC Certified Stickers. You CAN remove the Manufacturer Warning Labels once you read them.

Front Stickers

- Place Number(s) on the top front of helmet.
- Place Front Chargers Nameplate over helmet brand name. <u>NOTE</u>: Sticker may not cover all of the brand name, this is ok.

Back Stickers

- Place Number(s) on the back middle of helmet.
- Place American Flag below the Number(s) but not on bottom.
- Place CSDHL or NIHL Sticker on Lower Right.

Side Stickers

- Place Side Chargers Banner on the back half of the two-piece shell as close to the center as possible or centered on a one-piece helmet. Do your best to match the curve of the top of the helmet with the arch of the sticker.
- Place Side Chargers Banner on the same spot for both sides of the helmet.
