

All League Baseball (ALB)/Charlotte Metro USSSA Ejections and Suspensions

- The following actions constitute a Level 1 ejection:
 - Continued arguing or conduct that is unbecoming and/or abusive towards umpires over judgment calls (balls and strikes, out and safe, fair and foul, etc)
 - o Entering the field of play to approach an umpire without time being granted
 - Use of profanity towards an umpire, opposing team member or ALB USSSA staff or event official
 - USSSA rules violations
 - PENALTY: Level 1 ejection will carry a one game suspension in addition to being removed from the game in which the ejection took place
- The following actions constitute a **Level 2 ejection**:
 - Excessive arguing or conduct that is unbecoming and/or abusive towards umpires over judgment calls (balls and strikes, out and safe, fair and foul, etc)
 - o Entering the field of play to approach an umpire without time being granted
 - Use of profanity towards an umpire, opposing team member or ALB USSSA staff or event official
 - Any physical contact with an umpire, opposing team member or ALB USSSA staff or event official
 - Offensive remarks including but not limited to race, ethnicity, gender, religion or sexuality
 - Threats made towards an umpire, opposing team member or ALB USSSA staff or event official
 - USSSA rules violations (including USSSA Rule 14.02 explicitly)
 - PENALTY: Level 2 ejections carry at least a remainder of weekend suspension regardless of the severity of the situation. A Level 2 ejection that occurs on the final day of the event will carry over to the offender's next event. Review of incident report may deem a multi-weekend or indefinite suspension from ALB USSSA events

ALB Charlotte site directors will be required to submit an incident report for every ejection. Ejection levels and penalties may be upgraded, reduced or rescinded upon review by the All League Baseball office and/or NC USSSA state office.
