Girls Basketball Tournament Rules:

In addition to WIAA rules:

- 18-minute halves. Continuous running clock except during the last two minutes of each half and overtime for any stoppage of play (unless a team is leading by 15 points or more). Halftime will be 3 minutes.
- Three (3) one-minute timeouts per game, one (1) per overtime, no carryovers
- 2-minute overtime; second overtime – first basket wins
- Only 1 coach (Head Coach) may stand while game is in progress
- Bonus on 7th team foul, double bonus on 10th team foul
- Technical fouls will be automatic 2 points and possession
- (2) technical fouls on any player or coach is an automatic ejection from the tournament
- 3-minute warm-up if time permits
- No protests allowed, official's decisions are final

Defense and Pressing

- 3rd Grade/4th Grade B
 - Man to man defense only! Cannot extend past the 3pt line. Help defense allowed, but must help and recover.
 - No press
 - Defense can be extended to half court for last 2 minutes of the game.
- 4th Grade A
 - Man to man half court defense only. Defense can extend out to half court. Help defense is allowed but must help and recover.
 - Man to man press is allowed during the last 2 minutes of the game
- 5th Grade
 - Man to man half court defense only. Help defense is allowed but must help and recover.
 - Man to man press is allowed during the last 2 minutes of each half and all of overtime
- 6th Grade
 - Man to man to man defense only. Help defense is allowed but must help and recover.
 - Can press at any time, except if winning team is up by 15+ points
- 7th/8th Grade
 - Any defense allowed throughout the entire game. No press if winning by 15+ points.

Admission: \$6 for adults, \$3 for seniors, \$2 for students, 5 and under free
All military personnel showing ID are free
Only two coaches per team will be free

Concessions: Provided at tournament. Please no carry-in food or beverages.

Basketballs: Teams must provide their own balls for warm-ups.
Spalding TF1000 Game balls will be provided by tournament for use in game.

Awards: Awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each grade (12 maximum per team)
