Summer Teams Update

Subject: Mighty Strikers has started. Over 200 kids signed up now, about 20 late sign ups this year.

Ref Update

Subject: Nelaina Daggett is visiting the meeting to discuss Ref concerns.

Justin mentioned we can ask teams coming to DL if they have refs who are willing to travel to DL to help. Wil pay them accordingly with stipend for travel.

We need to recruit more refs. Will need refs for Rotary Cup for sure. Justin is reaching out to the Fargo clubs for assistance with that tournament.

Nelaina would like to partner with a board member to help recruit younger refs over the off-season. Also, how do we mentor the younger refs to build their confidence to feel comfortable during game situations? Lack of refs this year is a challenge with the mentoring idea, but this was something that occurred in the past with more experienced refs watching younger refs and then doing after game reviews to go over the game/talk about what went well and what could have been better.

There are a couple refs (Pelican Rapids)/soccer knowledgeable people in nearby towns and within DL that may be able to help. Need to contact them and get them going to help.

Joe Braun volunteered to work with Nelaina to start a recruitment program over the off-season.

Possibly send out a snap survey to former refs to get a sense of what are the issues that are leading to refs leaving.

As a safety issue we should discuss the need for 3 refs for games for U16s and U18s with other teams.

Referee Pay-Currently our referee fees are similar to other best paying leagues. We need to ensure that we remain competitive with the pay. Current policy says that if ref is there and game does not occur, ref gets paid. If game starts but ends early, ref gets paid. If ref is notified 24 hours before game that game is cancelled, ref does not get paid.

Joe will try to get some idea what current ref pay is across the district for regular and cluster games. Look over club websites and get contacts. Will try to report back by next meeting.

Discussion noted that pay for refs would remain the same for time being.
