First order of business was to approve the minutes from the February meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Brock Barton and seconded by Allison Mancuso. The motion passed.

Age group updates were given briefly as most was covered in President Meyer's prior Annual Meeting speech.

- a. 14u - Brock reported 14u Green won states and lost in semis at Regionals. The Blue team lost a heartbreaker in the semi-finals of the state tournament. Brock shared that he attended a Woodstock Board meeting. They were very complimentary of the Swarm collaboration.
- b. 12u - Will shared that 12u Blue won states and went to regionals and lost in the semis. 12u Black lost a shootout heartbreaker in the semis of the state tournament.
- c. 10u - Jen reviewed that Blue finished 4th in the regular season and had tough pool play opponents for the GSL state tournament. Black finished 2nd in the regular season and won states with a win over Hanover. Hanover shared that there was great sportsmanship from Black in the finals.
- d. 8u - Allison reported 8u ended the season with four full ice practices to help prepare and educate our players for full ice games. If we play in the GSL next season, there is an opportunity for some full ice games and our players will be better prepared.

Mom Skills Night was another new fundraiser that got rave reviews and we hope to continue in the future! The Skate-a-thon is in two days and we are ready to go! The board did some last minute details planning that then moved on. Will started looking ahead to the golf tournament and said we want to do it again but still need to secure a venue.
- f. Girls Development - They finished with a great group last Friday night. Allison noted that the girls didn't go to a Dartmouth game this season and wants to do it next year.
- g. Scheduler - No Update
- h. Equipment Manager - We need to purchase pinnies for next year's 14u tryouts and more quick change pads for 8u.
- i. Marketing/Social Media - Denise has been a rock star this year. She has a great social media plan coming up.
- j. Safety/Concussion - One concussion from Pot of Gold. That player will need a fall evaluation.
