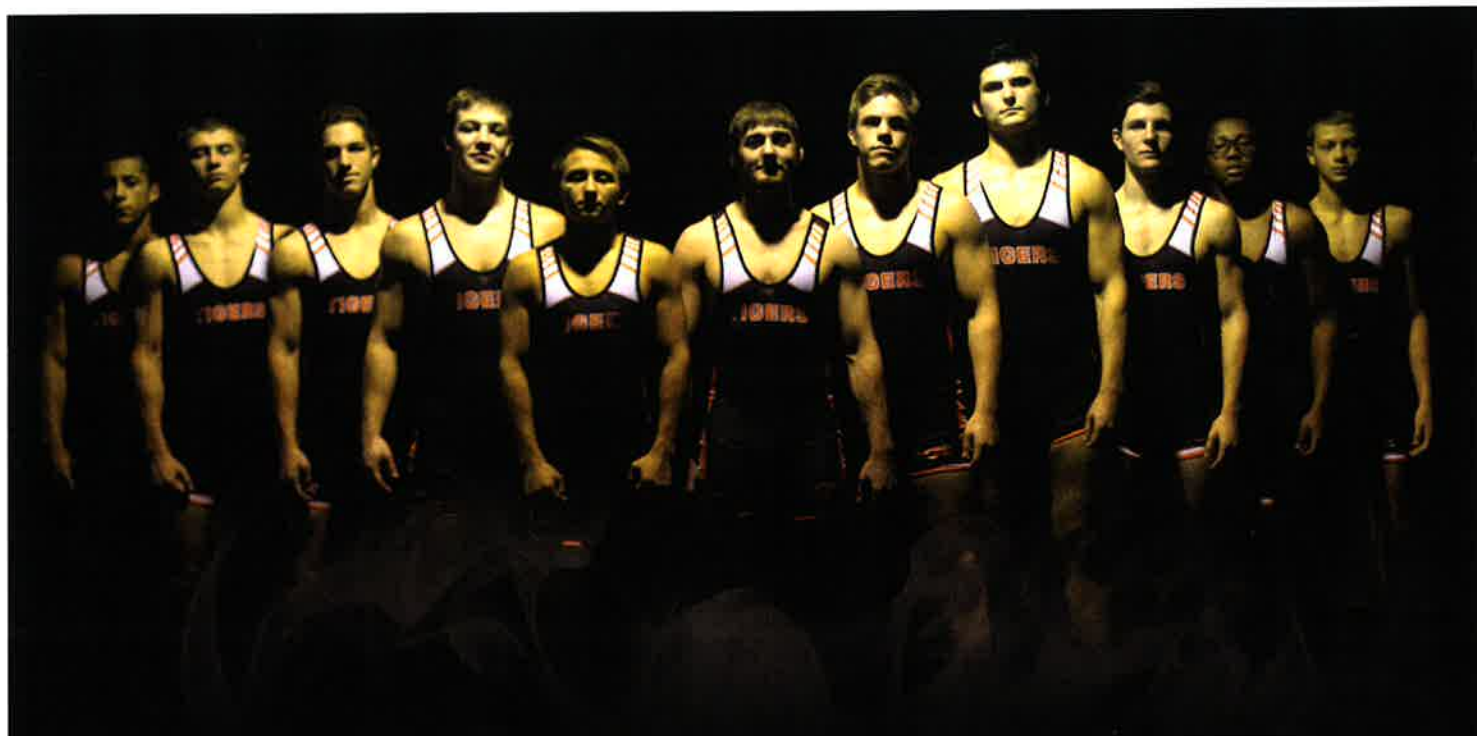

Varsity Overview

Tonight is a farewell to another great wrestling season, and a good – bye to 4 special Seniors. The 2014-15 wrestling team did not take a back seat to anyone. When predictors said we are too young, we proved them wrong. Although last year's team graduated twelve seniors and over 250 varsity wins (just last year's wins – not career), the 14-15 squad was determined to carry on the tradition. The 2015 Tiger wrestlers completed a 20-5 regular season record and were crowned Southwest Conference Champions for the 4th year in a row. After an early season loss to conference opponent – Belleville West, the Tigers charged back to win the conference title – outright, and rein as Regional Champs. This was an outstanding effort as many of the wrestlers were new to fill full time Varsity spots. We used an abundance of wrestlers throughout the year to gain these accomplishments. Like many times – it was “Next Man Up” to accomplish our feats. The sectional tournament was no disappointment as the Tigers went 4 for 4 in the “Go or Go Home round”, and sent 4 individuals to the State Tournament. Although our last match was a loss, and our goal to get to Team State was not accomplished, the wrestlers put it all on the line and just came up short. It will be another season to be remembered, and I can only hope the life lessons will help forever and the friendships gained will always be continued.

So what took place to propel another great season? It was hard work. To be able to work hard, fight off your back, wrestler sore, make weight, lose multiple times, and PUSH THRU PAIN – puts you into a special group – TIGER WRESTLERS. The attributes not only helped you this season, but can help you for a lifetime. Wrestlers - thanks for a great season. Stat girls - thanks for all of you countless help during the season, helping us accomplish what we did.

This year's Seniors were short in numbers, but not effort. They will not leave many holes in the line – up – but they will be big holes. The conference is getting sick of us winning, and will place another target on our back, like many of the teams did this year. Getting to the top is tuff, but staying there is even more of a challenge. We have many returning letterman, along with undefeated j.v. and freshman teams. But this does not guarantee wins. It will continue to take hard work and dedication, which is what wrestling, is all about. We have lost 4 sectionals championships in a row. Let's dedicate to have the feeling we felt the last four years in our last match – be a feeling we don't want. Let's work so we don't have to feel that way again. One guarantee is that we truly have the best interest of your kids at heart. Although some decisions are hard, and maybe don't seem right – they are not malicious or to be harmful. Edwardsville Wrestling is and will always be many people working to a common goal – the goal of “Building Champions” on and off the mat.

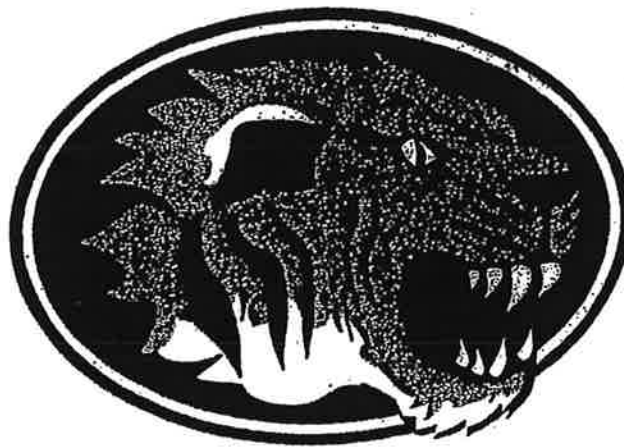

Junior Varsity Overview

This year's junior varsity team had another outstanding campaign. The team proved during the course of the season they are more than capable of carrying on the winning tradition of "**Tiger Style**" wrestling as many teams before them have. Our coaching staff looks forward to watching each of you grow in the sport of wrestling and competing for us at the varsity level in the very near future. For this to happen you must continue to work hard this offseason at your craft and prepare yourselves for the many challenges varsity level wrestling will present to you. Choosing to commit to our off-season program will allow the best opportunity for each of you to take the next step in accomplishing your wrestling goals.

This year's team had a dual meet record of 19-0, a very impressive season for a team with very few juniors and a competitive schedule. The team competed in three tournaments this season: Mehlville JV Duals (1st Place/16 teams), St. Charles West Varsity Tournament (10th Place/ 19 teams), and the Southwest Conference JV Dual Championships (1st Place).

The team traveled to Mehlville High School over Christmas break once again this season to participate in their annual holiday dual tournament. The team competed extremely hard and dominated the competition going 5-0 and capturing the team title for the fourth consecutive season.

The next stop for the J.V. team was at the St. Charles West Varsity Tournament. This was a new date on the schedule for the J.V. team but important for us as a program to test our younger wrestlers against varsity level competition. It also allowed us to get matches for wrestlers in our program that would be varsity starters on most other teams in the area. I was extremely proud of the way the team competed (10th Place) and came away feeling fired up about the future of our younger wrestlers and the direction of the program.

The team finished their season of competition with the Southwest Conference J.V. Dual Tournament. The Tigers dominated their competition once again going 3-0 in pool play. In route to winning the **SOUTHWEST CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP** the team defeated East St. Louis, Alton and Belleville East. This was a great way to finish a perfect season of competition. Many of our wrestlers finished in the top three and we crowned more individual champions than any other conference school.

I would like to thank the parents of all the wrestlers for supporting their sons this season, without your support it would be very difficult to be the program we are today. I appreciate the time you allow us to spend with your sons and helping you mold them into great young men of character on and off the mat.

I would also like to thank the senior wrestlers and managers for their hard work, dedication, and passion for the program the past four year. It really means a lot to me and the rest of the coaching staff that have had a hand in helping you develop in this great sport over your careers. I would also like to thank the parents of the seniors for always being there for your sons/daughters.
