Monthly Financial Summary:

Our checking account balance as of 9/29/25 is \$222,603.34. Our savings account balance as of 9/29/25 is \$107,015.64. Combined total of \$329,618.98. The checking account balance on this date last year was \$236,899.30. We did not have a savings account this time last year (savings account was opened on 1/24/25).

Activity since 8/31/25:
