GOING FOR A SECOND HELPING IN SIOUX CITY

LAST GAME - CHICAGO: The Steel took down the Sioux City Musketeers by a 6-3 score in the first of a two-game set at Tyson Events Center on Saturday night. Chicago scored five goals in the middle frame, the highest-scoring period of the season. Three Steel goals were scored with the man advantage out of five chances (60%) while the team killed off 3-of-4 (75%) penalties taken. With the victory, Chicago extended its win streak to a season-best four contests. **Brendan Brisson** scored two power-play goals and added a helper while **Erik Middendorf** and **Josh Doan** tallied their first goals as members of the Steel. **Victor Ostman** picked up the win in net, stopping 31 shots. **Ostman** now owns a record of 8-2-0-0, tied for the most wins in the USHL.

LAST GAME - SIOUX CITY: The Musketeers out-shot the Steel 33-22 but fell 6-3 on Saturday night to Chicago. Sioux City goals were scored by **Sam Stange**, **Christian Jimenez** and **Viktor Masilevich**. Netminder **Ethan Haider** made 11 saves before being replaced by **Aiden Harper** who turned away five shots in the relief appearance.

AGAINST THE MUSKETEERS: Chicago looks for a clean weekend sweep of the Musketeers with a 24-26-4-4 all-time record versus Sioux City heading into Sunday's action and a 13-13-0-4 mark as the visiting team. The clash on Sunday is the third and final regular-season meeting between the teams with the Steel holding a 2-0-0-0 mark through the first two matchups.

SHOWTIME SEAN: With a goal and two assists in the win on Saturday, Chicago forward **Sean Farrell** reached his career-best mark for single-season points in the USHL with 23 (7G, 16A) through 15 appearances this year. His previous career best was 20 points (5G, 15A) in 34 games for Team USA during the 2017-18 campaign. The Hopkinton, Mass., native stands alone atop the USHL in scoring and carries a six-game point streak (3G, 9A) into Sunday's contest. Farrell was rated as a 'C'-level prospect on NHL Central Scouting's most recent watch list on Nov. 11.

THE KILLERS: With an 88.9 percent penalty-kill success rate, the Steel own the league's third-best shorthanded unit as of Nov. 17. The club has surrendered just six power-play goals against in 15 games, tied for the second-fewest in the league thus far. Chicago has yet to give up more than one power-play goal against in a single game.

SCOUTING SIOUX CITY: Defenseman **Dominic Vidoli** is the only blueliner in the league to lead his team outright in points with 11 (3G, 8A) in eight games played this season. The Raleigh, N.C., native has tallied three helpers in two appearances against the Steel this year. Forward **Viktor Masilevich** led the Musketeers with a goal and an assist in the loss on Saturday night, his first multi-point outing this season. The 6-foot-1, 176-pound skater now has seven points (3G, 4A) in his first season in the USHL.
