In order to participate in the CMFL, all coaches are required to review, sign and acknowledge this coach agreement

You, as a coach or assistant coach, will likely make a lasting impression on your participants. You represent yourself, your program and this league and we ask that you always exhibit professional conduct. Your actions and words will be seen and heard by many during the season. Because of that, we ask that on behalf of the children and spectators that you exhibit yourself professionally and make youth sports a positive experience for you and your football community.

I agree to conduct myself in an appropriate manner, will cooperate with other coaches, officials, and parents, to be a role model, and to adhere to the rules established by the Central Maine Football League.

I will promote the concepts of safety, fun, sportsmanship and CMFL rules.

- Coaches are expected to represent their own communities and CMFL in a positive manner by displaying good sportsmanship and respect towards peers, officials and opponents at all times.
- You are expected to have a system in place to address inappropriate behavior from your own football community.
- Bullying will not be tolerated on any level including thru social media.
- Arguing with officials will not be tolerated. Communication between yourself and officials should remain courteous and respectful.
- Profanity and unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
- Use of property: Take care of your belongings, including food and trash.
- Pets: Are not allowed on school/athletic facilities.
- Use of Tobacco products (Including vaping), Marijuana & Alcohol are not allowed on school/athletic facilities.
- I will not cheat or engage in any form of unethical behavior that violates league rules.
- I will be knowledgeable of the CMFL rules.

I have read and understand that I am expected to follow the above CMFL coach agreement. I understand that if I violate any of this agreement that it could result in suspension of one or more games.
