a. NATIONAL BOUND TEAMS MUST PLAY 2 HOME AND 2 AWAY GAMES WITH ALL OF THE OTHER NATIONAL BOUND TEAMS IN THEIR USA HOCKEY AGE CLASSIFICATION AND DECLARED LEVEL. 50% OF ALL REQUIRED GAMES MUST BE PLAYED BY NOVEMBER 15 OF THE CURRENT PLAYING SEASON.

EACH TIER II NATIONAL BOUND TEAM YOUTH (14U, 16U, 18U, AND GIRLS 14U, 16U, 19U) THAT HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED BY THEIR ASSOCIATION REPRESENTATIVE AT THE PNAHA ANNUAL FALL MEETING MUST PLAY EACH NATIONAL BOUND TEAM IN THEIR AGE CLASSIFICATION A MINIMUM OF 2 GAMES DURING THE SEASON. 50% OF THE REQUIRED GAMES MUST BE COMPLETED BY NOVEMBER 15 AND THE REMAINDER MUST BE COMPLETED 14 DAYS PRIOR TO THE AFFILIATE TOURNAMENT.

INTENTION OF PROPOSAL:

- The current league rules regarding the number of games that must be played (2 Home and 2 Away page 72) are inconsistent with PNAHA National Bound requirements (minimum 2 games page 57).
- This rule change would default to the historical PNAHA rule wherein each declared National Bound team would play all other NTB teams a minimum of 2 games during the season (thus removing the requirement for 2 Home and 2 Away games).
