Minutes

- Agendas and meeting minutes from 12/19/21 were distributed and reviewed. A motion was made by Kattre, second by Schrimpf, to approve the minutes as presented. Motion passed, 8-0

Financials

- Schrimpf provided financial update and update financial statement. Tournament revenue will possibly be down slightly due to lesser teams. No other major changes, budget is tracking as expected, possibly under at end of year depending upon income from tournaments, etc.

2020-2021 Calendar

- Group discussed upcoming tournaments on 1/29-30, 2/5-6 and 2/12-13. Group discussed upcoming OYBL Picture Day and Food Drive on 2/19.

OYBL

- Group discussed moving 1st and 2nd grade sessions to FES in the future. All agree setup is nice, minimizes need to hang hoops, provides viewing for parents outside of gym. Will also limit down time due to home travel tournaments. Decided we will move to FES for 2022-2023 season.
- Group discussed OYBL Food Drive and Picture Day. Kattre will coordinate with OAFP for logistics on food pickup/delivery. Discussed possibly having HS kids help direct traffic, assist with donations since they will be there for ½ grade sessions. Also discussed need for additional 1-2 Board members to be onsite 7am-1pm to help assist.
- Kattre and Younggren will continue to message OYBL coaches and participants with Picture Day schedules and Food Drive logistics. Will also send reminders via email and social media.

Travel

- Group discussed Home Tournaments, confirmed days and times for setup. Siebert and Wamsley indicated both will be around for tournaments, HS kids will be there to do table/book.
- Kevin Schmidt and Younggren will coordinate purchasing of concessions and supplies for tournaments.
- Kevin Schmidt is coordinating all referees for tournaments. We decided to increase referee pay per game to ensure quality officiating.
- Group discussed that court sponsorship will be tabled for this year and proposed to prospective sponsors for next year.
- Group discussed BDL Mask Policy and enforcement. Feltz indicated and provided email regarding BDL policy and relative lack of enforcement. Group discussed possibly contacting BDL for discussion, but decided against. Decided our teams will follow our policies and we will remind our teams and coaches, but we cannot control what other teams choose to do.
- Younggren shared travel teams BDL records to date, discussed competitive balance. Group discussed looking at enrolling 5th grade split teams in lower BDL division in future.
- Group discussed possibly looking at WYBL as an option for some travel teams in the future.

- Heitz was absent, indicated beforehand offline no major OSD updates to report outside of recommending at request of OSD, additional day-of signage and messaging to all teams regarding mask requirement for upcoming tournaments.
