We discussed all possible scenarios for extending our current meet season

- looked at our current numbers for all levels in KY
- talked about what other states in our region are doing
- they are all still having meets and state meets
- what's happening with our regional meets and how would an extension affect those meets
- only having compulsories extended
- new compulsory routines are coming up
- doing virtual meets
- adding more meets to the current schedule
- will more meets get canceled
- current judges available, out due to Covid concerns
- gymnasts in and out due to Covid quarantines
- have in house sanctioned meets with only one other club

***Debbie Klotz motioned that we DO NOT extend our current meet season/schedule

We discussed all possible scenarios concerning our KY State Meet

- current host clubs not able to secure the venues because of Covid resections
- hosting in house
- having a virtual state meet
- admission restricted
- guardians restricted
- renting equipment anyway to be fair for all competing
- paying for virtual services
- have a state meet no matter what to let the kids compete
- Excels venue ok at the time of this meeting
- Legacy's venue not ok at the time of this meeting
- Regional meets are virtual then our state meet must be virtual
- Changing our current state meet requirements for scoring
- Changing the KQ requirements
- Levels 2-5 in person and 6 and up virtual

***Michael Crowe-Nance motioned to have NO score requirements and NO KQ requirements to attend this year's 2021 KY State Meet. For all levels and divisions, but you must attend ONE USAG sanctioned meet at the level you will be competing at state meet. Debbie Klotz 2nd the motion-Passed**

***Michael Crowe-Nance motioned that we can have this year's state meet in house and that pending regional meets are going virtual then our levels that are trying to achieve a regional qualifying score at state meet also compete state meet virtually. Angela Dickey 2nd the motion-Passed**

Judging Concerns

We discussed possibly having some issues assigning judges to meets due to some being out because of Covid and changing our current meet schedule to accommodate the earlier meets that were canceled and then rescheduled to weekends that already had a meet scheduled. Most states are having this same issue so it's hard to pull from other states. We talked about having one judge panels for levels 2 through 5, optional on Saturdays and Compulsories on Sundays to try and get judges to each meet. Michael discussed that we really had just two bad weekends and we can have a text message meeting to discuss what happens next after he can get more information concerning the large Ozone meet that has now lost its venue due to Covid. If they change their weekend or do not have the meet all together then we should be ok. We will wait to get more information on Ozone before any decision is made on a one judge panel.

We set a date and time for the current non judge committee members to rank our KY Judges for State and Regional meets. Date=June 19-20, 2021 will be the KY New Compulsory Workshop
