

HUMEWOOD & SUMMERSTRAND BEACHFRONT:

Residents are advised that Marine Drive, Beach Road, Humewood Road between Admiralty Way & the M4 Settlers Highway will be impacted by the IRONMAN Events taking place on Saturday, 20 April & Sunday, 21 April 2024.

ISUZU CORPORATE TRIATHLON CHALLENGE | 20 April 2024

The road closures are in place from 06:30 - 11:30

Marine Drive / Beach Road / Humewood Road lanes in the direction of the harbour are open to traffic from Second Avenue up to La Roche Drive and beyond.

Beach Road / Marine Drive lanes in the direction of Summerstrand are closed between La Roche Drive and Second Avenue.

Marine Drive is fully closed from Second Avenue to Noordhoek Camp Site. Noordhoek / Willows access via Walmer / Victoria Drive.

Pine lodge and Cape Recife Nature Reserve is accessible from NMU

South Campus back gate on Marine Drive, via University Way and Protea Road. Take note of a controlled soft road shoulder lane, parallel to Marine Drive.

IRONMAN AFRICAN CHAMPIONSHIP & IRONMAN 70.3 NELSON MANDELA BAY | 21 April 2024

Beach Front : Marine Drive, Beach Road, Humewood Road are all closed to all traffic from Admiralty Way up to the M4 in South End from 05:00 to midnight.

Humerail Spar/ Perrott Avenue are accessible via Forest Hill Drive / Mitchell Street / Lawhill Road and Newcon Street.

Driftsands Drive's city bound lane will be closed from 05:00 - 14:00, and Summerstrand bound lanes will be closed from 05:00 to midnight.

Humewood Flats o Beach Road between La Roche Drive and Ocean Avenue will have one directional lane use, anticlockwise around the block they are on.

Lodge Road and Brookes Hill Road are accessible via Happy Valley Drive behind the Garden Court Kings Beach in a special lane created on Beach Road from 05:00 to midnight. This lane terminates at Lodge Road and there is no thoroughfare to Marine Drive / Summerstrand from there.

Second Avenue in Summerstrand is closed from Marine Drive to Skegness Road.

The following beach parking areas are closed to vehicle access: Kings Beach, Hobie Beach, Pollock Beach & Pipe Beach Parking. The public may walk along the closed roads to these beaches.

M4 SETTLERS HIGHWAY INTERSECTION TO 3RD

AVENUE WALMER:

Walmer Boulevard/ Heugh Road from M4 to 3rd Avenue Walmer west bound lanes will be closed to traffic flow from 05:00 to 17:00. Traffic may flow from 3rd / 2nd / 1st Avenue leftwards (east bound) direction the M4 / Harbour. The lanes in the opposite direction will be closed.

The following will be controlled points to cross the Bike course:

- Forrest Hill Drive, South End
- 3rd Avenue, Walmer

HEUGH ROAD/ BUFFELSFONTEIN ROAD FROM 3RD AVENUE TO 10TH AVENUE WALMER:

Heugh Road / Buffelsfontein Road will be closed from 3rd Avenue to 10th Avenue Walmer from 05:00 - 17:00 on Sunday.

The following will be controlled points to cross the bike course:

- 3rd Avenue Walmer
- 6th Avenue Walmer
- 9th Avenue Walmer
- 10th Avenue Walmer

Alternatively, vehicles can park at a nearby area off the official course and walk.

HEUGH ROAD/ BUFFELSFONTEIN ROAD FROM 10TH AVENUE TO 17TH AVENUE WALMER:

Heugh Road/ Buffelsfontein Road will be closed from 10th Avenue to 17th Avenue Walmer from 05:00 - 17:00 on Sunday.

The following will be controlled points to cross the Bike course:

- 10th Avenue, Walmer
- Swift Avenue / Sasol Garage
- 17th Avenue, Walmer

BUFFELSFONTEIN ROAD FROM 17TH AVENUE TO OLD SEAVIEW ROAD:

Buffelsfontein Road will be closed from 17th Avenue Walmer to Old Seaview Road (Mount Pleasant access road) from 05:00 - 17:00 on Sunday.

The following will be controlled points to cross the Bike course:

- 17th Avenue
- Walter Road
- Melssetter Road/High Street
- Sadelwood Villas into Hilltop Road

SEAVIEW ROAD, DEER PARK, KINI BAY, THE VILLAGES OF SEAVIEW AND BEACHVIEW TO DE STADES ROAD (M9)

Residents are advised that **Seaview Road** from Old Seaview Road / Elizabeth Road to De Stades, including Seaview and Beachview Villages are part of the IRONMAN bike course and will carry athletes cycling in both directions on this two-lap course. There will be full road closures in place between 05:00 and 17:00.

Milkwood Lane residents may exit their premises up to 07:15 onto Seaview Road. They must travel in the direction of Link Road. Exit Seaview at Link Road and make use of Old Seaview Road in the direction of Kragga Kamma Road. They will only be able to return to their premises after 16:30.

Deer Park & Bushy Park residents may exit their premises up to 07:15 onto Seaview Road. They must travel in the direction of Beachview & exit at Old Seaview lower road, or the next city bound road. They will, however, not be able to drive back to their premises before the roads are reopened at approx 16:30.

Kini Bay residents may depart their homes up to 07:20 and must travel in the direction of Seaview Village. They can only return via Seaview Village to Kini Bay at approx 16:00.

Seaview & Clarendon Marine residents north (landside) of Seaview Road and Elizabeth Road who can access their homes via Van Reenen Road, Reinett Road or Seaview Hotel Road are not affected, provided they use Seaview Road, in the direction of Colleen Glen/Kragga Kamma Road.

Residents who only have access onto Seaview Road/ Elizabeth or live in Nautilus Street or Chapman Road, must park their vehicles on the closest land side road that can lead them out of Seaview towards Colleen Glen on Seaview Road.

Beachview residents can exit right to Maitlands/ M9 via Seestrand Way/ Beachview Drive up to 07:30 and may only return after 16:00. They must exit/ enter Beachview Road via Maitlands/ De Stades Road.

HERON ROAD & SARDINIA BAY ROAD (GRASS ROOF & SARDINIA BAY GOLF ESTATE):

Residents are advised that Heron Road & Sardinia Bay Road are part of the IRONMAN Bike course and will carry athletes between Heron Road and the Humewood Beachfront on the two-lap course. During this time, there will be full road closure on these roads from 05:00 to 16:45.

Grass Roof is accessible via Link Road/ Old Seaview Road. Patrons must park in Link Road and walk across Seaview Road to Grass Roof at the controlled pedestrian crossing.

Sardinia Bay Golf Estate staff & residents are advised that on race day, vehicles may leave the premises up to 07:15. They must travel in the direction of Seaview Road via Heron Road where they can cross Seaview Road into Link Road and exit in the direction of Kragga Kamma/ Lorraine. They can return at approx 16:30 once the last athlete has passed.

Sardinia Bay Road residents may exit their properties into Heron Road until 07:15. They will need to use Link Road to Old Seaview Road, then from Old Seaview to Welcome Avenue to reach Lorraine or Kragga Kamma. They may only return after 16:30 via Link Road.

Please note: there will be no access to and from Sardinia Bay Beach during the event.

VICTORIA DRIVE, SCHOENMAKERSKOP VILLAGE & WILLOWS RESORT ACCESS:

Victoria Drive from Glendore Road up to Marine Drive are part of the IRONMAN bike course and will be closed for the duration of the event, from 05:00 - 17:00. IRONMAN athletes will complete two laps of the city and coastal route.

Guests, staff & residents are advised that on race day, vehicles may leave Schoenmakerskop Village and the Willows Resorts traveling in the direction of NMU, exiting via Marine Drive until 08:00.

For Willows Resorts guests checking in, there will be a convoy departing from Victoria Drive Intersection with Glendore Road in the direction of The Willows at 14:00. This convoy will travel on the left-hand side of the road, while athletes will be cycling on the right. The convoy will stop at The Willows Resort on the left-hand side of the road and will be controlled through the athletes, into the resort.

NOTE: all vehicles MUST remain behind the traffic officer and must adhere to the strict single vehicle cross-over into The Willows Resort only when instructed to do so by the Traffic Official.

Once all the vehicles have entered The Willows Resort, exiting guests will be guided across the road to the left-hand side only when it is safe to do so. These exiting vehicles must wait until the convoy is complete and will then be led by the Traffic Official along Marine Drive to exit at NMU back gate.

NOTE: The IRONMAN athletes always have the right of way.

CAPE RECIFE NATURE RESERVE (incl SANCCOB) & Pine Lodge access:

Pine Lodge and Cape Recife Nature Reserve is accessible from NMU South Campus back gate on Marine Drive via University Way and Protea Road. Take note of a soft shoulder lane, running parallel to Marine Drive (no heavy vehicles). This detour is in place on Sunday from 05:00 to midnight.
