- Set both **individual goals and team goals** to help make this a meaningful experience. Challenge yourself and your teammates.
- Play with pride, passion, and determination.
- Make each training session competitive. Push yourself as well as your teammates to improve each day.
- **DO NOT** be afraid to make a mistake!
- **COMMUNICATE!!** Talk to your captains, teammates, coaches, and parents. It is YOUR responsibility to discuss any concerns with your coaches.
- **BE A TEAM PLAYER**; trust your teammates and support **all** your teammates for the **unique person** they are. Compliment your teammates each day. Go out of your way to make Woodbury soccer a positive experience for everyone.
- **DEVELOP A ROLE ON THE TEAM**. Understand and accept your role on the team and the important contributions you make to the team and program.
- **BE A LEADER** on the field, in the classroom, in school, and throughout the community. Be a positive role model. Get involved in the community. Try to coach at the youth level, it's a great experience.
- BE COACHABLE!
- ALWAYS DISPLAY GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP. Be respectful of your teammates, coaches, opponents, parents, fans, and officials.
- Be responsible and organized:
- All players must complete at least one fitness test prior to playing in a game. Unless they are excused from fitness testing by the school's trainer.
- **BE ON TIME** to all training sessions, games, and team functions
- If you need to miss a training session, you must directly talk to one of the coaches. Unexcused training session, you must sit out one half of the next game. Three unexcused training sessions; you will be off the team.
- If you miss school (Unexcused), you cannot participate in soccer that day.
- All players must ride the bus to and from games when transportation is provided.
- Stay chemical free!
- GIVE YOUR BEST EFFORT IN THE CLASSROOM.
- Be aware of and follow all Woodbury High School, District 833, and MSHSL policies and rules.

- If you need to see a doctor due to an injury, you must get a note from the doctor that clears you to begin playing again.
- At the conclusion of the season, turn in all equipment **ON TIME!**Be a part of the **Woodbury Soccer Tradition**: play with pride, passion and determination; be committed to yourself, family, teammates, coaches, and your school; compete at your highest level each day; and enjoy your high school soccer experience!
