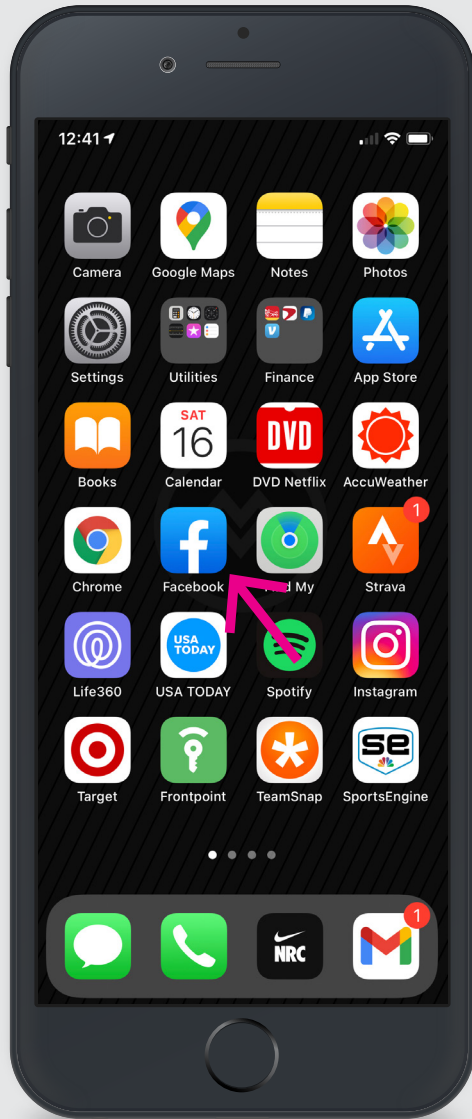
FACEBOOK APP

Broadcasting a game on Facebook Live via your team's Facebook Group Page

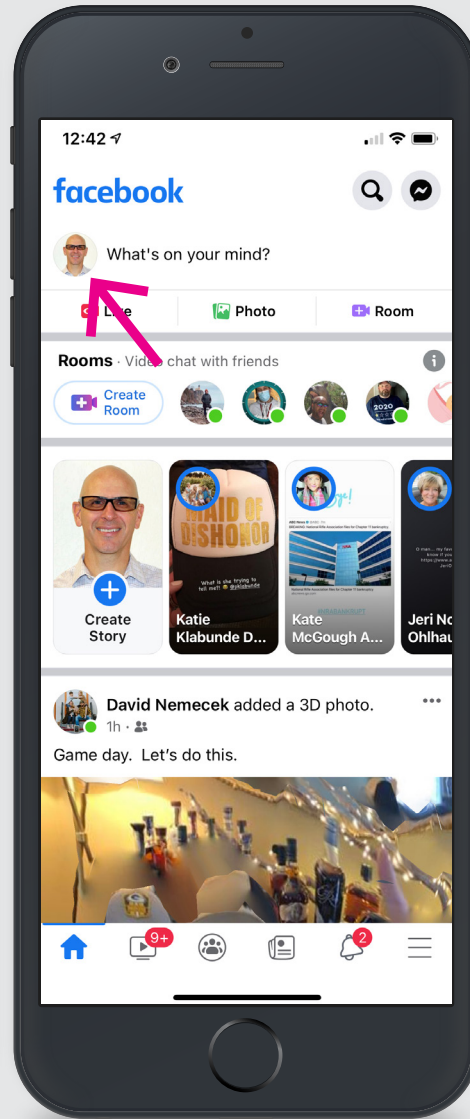
Tips:

- Use a phone or tablet
- Data (Cellular) connections work better than WiFi connections (data connections are more stable & consistent)
- Have the Facebook **APP** installed on your device
- Create a Mpls Lakers Team **Group Page** on Facebook page first (*example **Mpls Lakers Boys 8 Blue 2020-21***)
- Have a battery back up option, don't let your battery die at the end of a close game!
- Start with your device Vertically, then rotate it to Horizontal position (*more on this later*)
- When finished, **Save** your video first (to keep the video file) then **Share** it to your Team Group Page (*more on this later*)

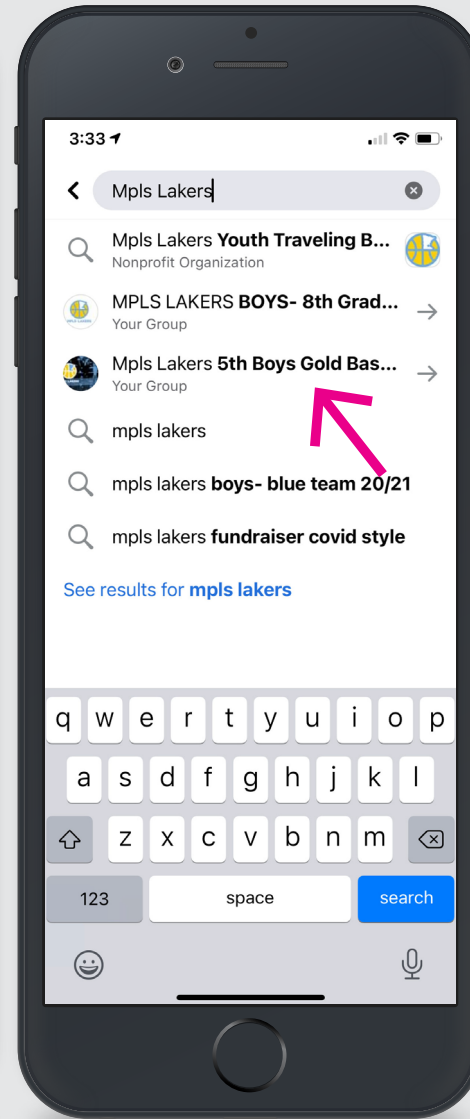
Getting started...



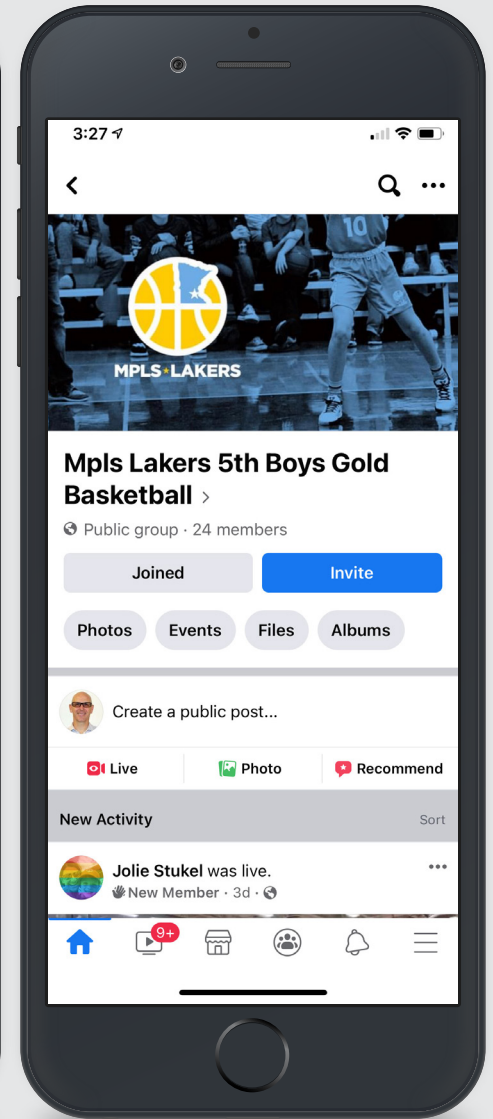
Have the Facebook App on your device



Launch the app, make sure you are signed in to your personal account

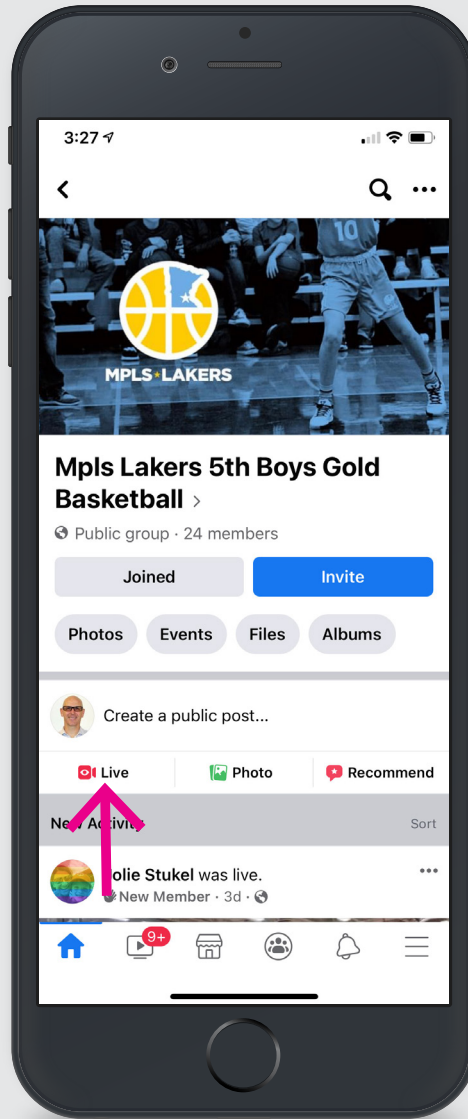


Search for the Mpls Lakers Team Group page.

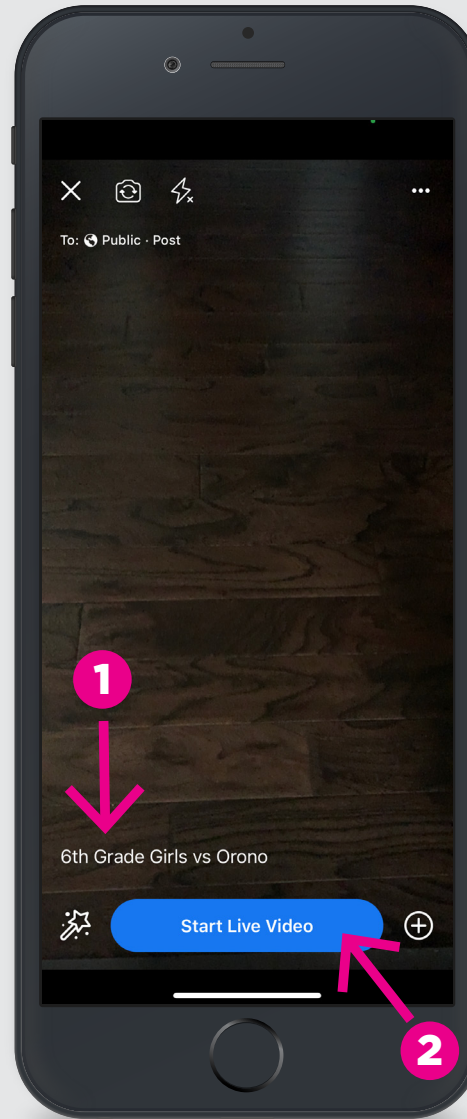


Tap on the Mpls Lakers page to go to it.

Launching



Locate the "Live" link and tap on it

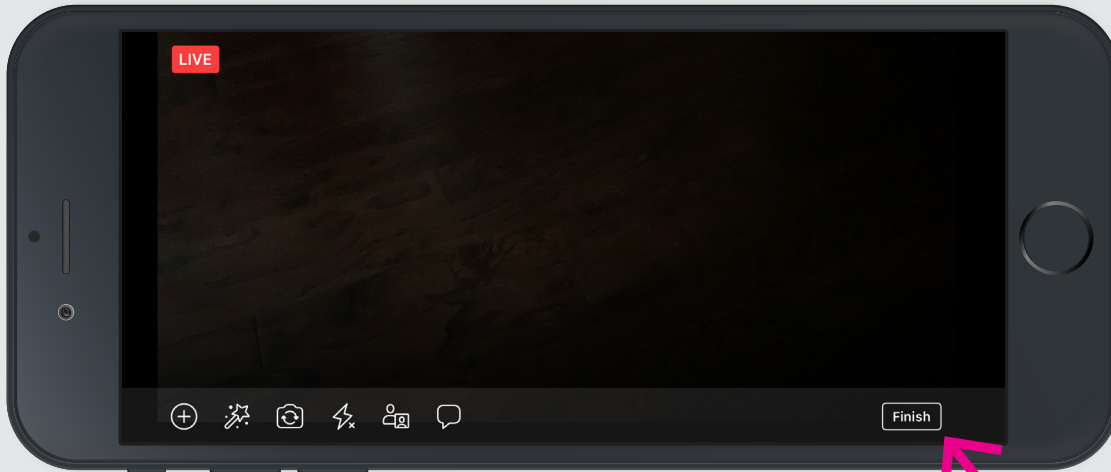


1. Name your event

2. Tap "Start Live Video"

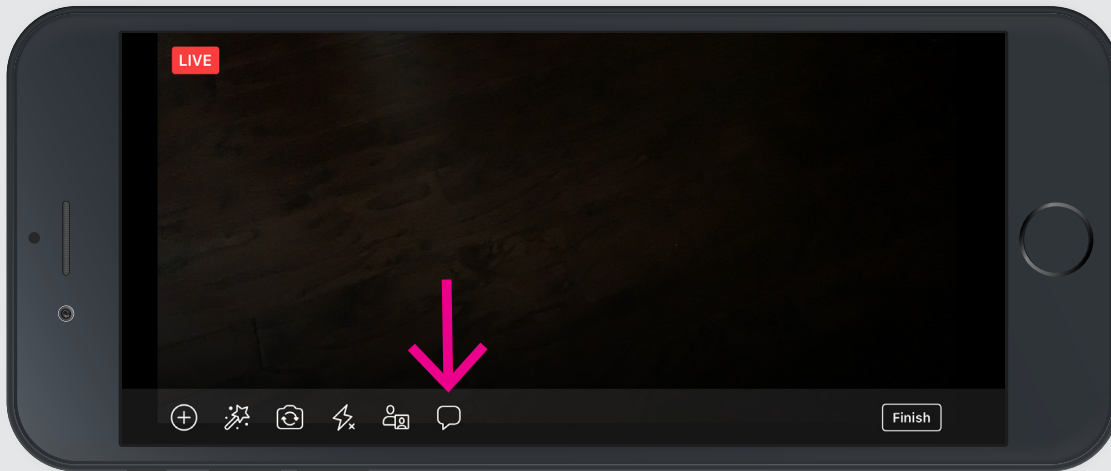
3. Immediately rotate your phone to the Horizontal position.

During and After

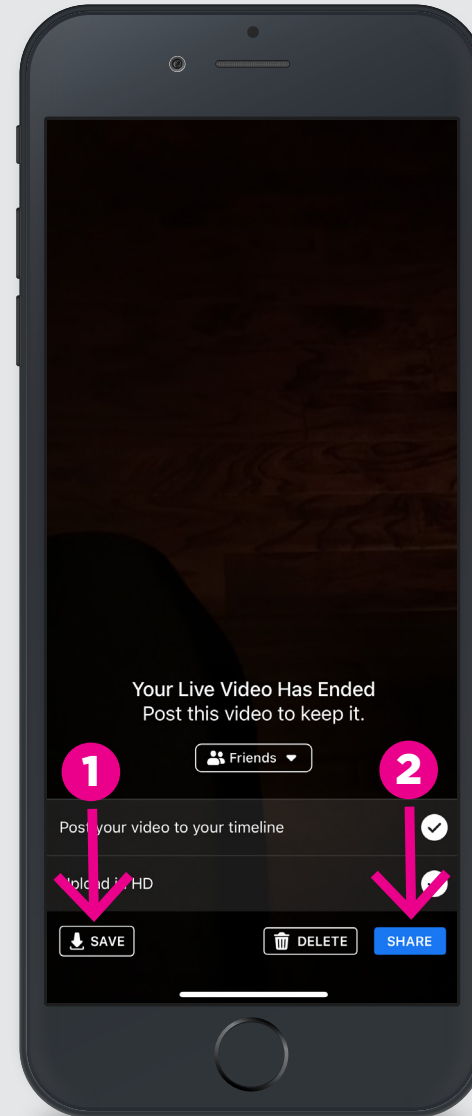


Putting your device into the Horizontal position lets you have much better coverage of the court. You won't have to do as much Panning of the camera (moving the camera to the players)

When the game is finished tap on the "Finish" button



During the event you can periodically indicate the score within the chat function



1. Tap on the "Save" button FIRST. This saves the video to your device.

2. Click the "Share" button to automatically upload the video to the Facebook Page.

This is optional, but is a good way to make sure that the video file has been saved for future viewing. (by accessing it on the Facebook page)
