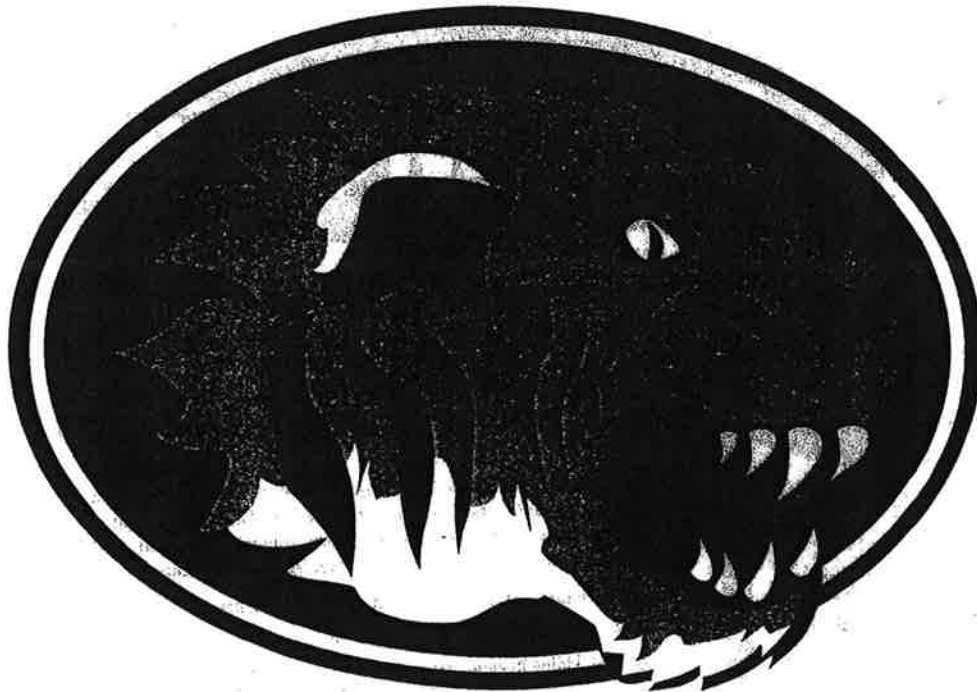

Junior Varsity Overview

The junior varsity team had another outstanding season. The wrestlers and their parents should be very proud of their accomplishments. This year's team had a dual meet record of 19-1, another very impressive season for a team that was made up of many freshman and sophomores. The team competed in three tournaments this season: Mehlville (2nd Place), Chatham Glenwood (2rd Place), and the Southwest Conference (SWC) JV Tournament (1st Place).

At Chatham Glenwood we wrestled extremely hard throughout the tournament with only twelve of the fifteen weight classes filled. The team knew going in they had their work cut out for them if they wanted to be team champions. They gave a courageous effort but fell short of their goal by missing taking 1st place by a half of a point. The tigers finished the tournament with more champions and top four placers than any other team.

At the SWC Tournament we beat a very athletic Belleville West team 46-17 in the first round of pool action. We then faced O'Fallon and showed no mercy by defeating them 51-9. In the championship we defeated a very good Collinsville team 47-30. As for individual accomplishments the team had every weight class represented in the medal round except for one.

The other tournament the JV team competed at this season was the Mehlville Dual Team Tournament. This was a great addition to our schedule since everyone that competed was able to get up to five matches. The competition was very good and the team did a great job of competing going 4-1 on the day. The team finished second to Seckman High School in a very exciting dual meet that came down to the last match of the meet.

I would like to thank the parents of all the wrestlers for supporting your sons in competing this year in our program. Without your support it would be very difficult to be the team and program we are today. We appreciate the time you allow us to spend with your sons and helping mold them into great young men of character on and off the mat.
