## Saints Fees Policy

Fees for the current season will be posted on the Saints website and available prior to registration.

A full accounting of costs and how fees are derived is available to any parent upon committing their child to play for the Saints.

A fee of \$35.00 will be applied to the member account if a check is returned unpaid by your banking institution for any reason.

A fee payment schedule will be established by the Board. Any player whose fees are not paid when due (more than 7 days late) will not be allowed to skate at practice or participate in a game as appropriate until the payment or payment arrangements are made.

The annual player registration fee includes ice time for team practices, skill development, home game ice slots, referee fees, and administrative costs.

In addition to the annual player fee, each player/family will be assessed any fees outside of the above items (optional tournaments, coach appreciation gifts, team manager appreciation gifts, etc.)

Required player equipment and uniform are the individual expense of the player/family.

To play for a Saints team, a player must register with KCYHA by completing the player registration and paying in full or pay their first payment of the current, offered payment plan.

No player will be allowed on the ice for any Saints session until the registration process is completed which will include:

- Completed on-line registration
- Payment(s) up to date
- USA Hockey on-line registration completed with player member number provided

Subsequent plan payments must be made on time, or the player will not be allowed to skate the week following the payment due date.

Families/Players with outstanding balances from a prior session will be required to pay that balance, plus the fees for the current season in **full** at time of registration. If fees are still owed, all State and League organizations will be notified that you are not financially released from the Saints.

Finance/ Fees policy is set by the Board of Directors. Neither coaches, team managers or Hockey Directors have the authority to alter the policy or make changes to the fess structure without prior Board approval.

Financial assistance (scholarships) will be awarded through an application process through the Scholarship Committee of the Board of Directors.
