## Treasurer:

- Wanted to discuss the contract with borough as it is more money than anticipated
  - They are charging \$3,680 of that the \$1150 will be the responsibility of Everly and Bros.
    - Everly and Bros did not use anywhere near that amount of propane. We will check if they will
    - This means we will pay \$2528 for just field and lights
      - In 2023 (just field rental fee and lights we paid \$2238)
      - In 2024 (just field usage and lights we paid \$2000)
    - Port-o-Potties were not cleaned or stocked with toilet paper for the game on 10/4
    - N. Mady- we are being charged more for receiving less (port-o-potties still maintaining the fields)
    - J. Sweeney- I say we sit on the contract until the end of the season and see what we can possibly get knocked off
    - E. Jayne- do we have receipts from bees
      - A. Clarke- does PAYAL own the shed, I would say that the shed is our responsibility to maintain
